- DNS Resolver Best Common Practice Task Force established
- EU Commission's public consultation on 'The future of the electronic communications sector and its infrastructure'
- EU Cyber Resilience Act

DNS Resolver Best Common Practice Task Force

- Initiated at RIPE 85 in response to DNS4EU
- Aims to provide Best Current Practices for operators of Open DNS Resolvers
- Will include recommendations for data privacy of users.

Feedback on Proposed EU Cyber Resilience Act

- Might reduce availability of open source software in Europe
- Needs clarity on open source software and activities “developed outside the course of commercial activities”.

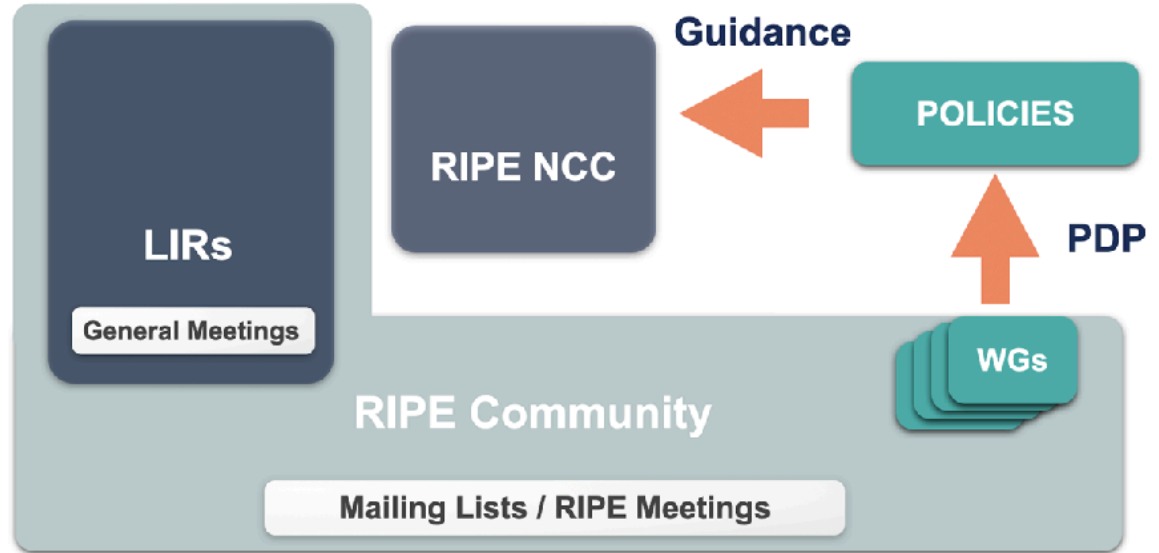

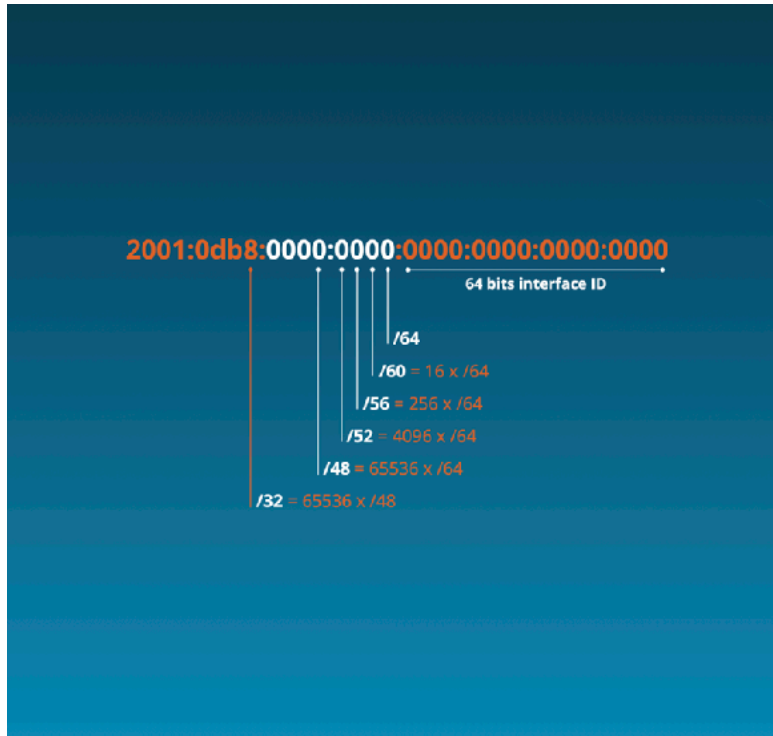
