



# Registration Overview






- 19,786 eligible voters

# Registered Votes per Country







Voting can take place once the Chair declares voting open

- Voting is available to all members who have registered to vote electronically.
- Votes can be cast until 09:00 (UTC+1) on Friday, 1 December 2023.
- There are NO paper ballots at this GM.
- Important: You need to complete the whole voting process for your vote to be validated. If you leave the platform before casting your ballot, no votes will be registered.

To login to the voting platform, click on the "Vote Now" button below.


Please note that the voting platform will only be accessible when the Chair of the Executive Board opens the election at approximately 18:00 UTC+1.

Click the 'Vote Now' button or link in the email to start voting.






Voting Code 1 is prefilled.

You will need Voting Code 2 (GM Registration Number) to log in.






You can choose Yes, No or Abstain.


You must choose one option to continue.






If you have several votes, you can assign them differently per resolution.





Confirm your vote.






Cast your ballot.

# Voting on Resolutions



- There are two Resolutions to be voted on:
- Resolution 1 requires more than 50% YES votes to pass
- Resolution 2 requires more than two-thirds YES votes to pass

Note: Abstentions are noted, but do not count!

**Resolution 1 -** "The General Meeting approves the redistribution of the excess contribution/deficit paid in 2023 by redistributing the RIPE NCC 2023 surplus/deficit to the membership in 2024."

#### Resolutions



**Resolution 2 -** "The General Meeting, in accordance with Article 21 of the Articles of Association, adopts the amendments to Articles 10 and 11.5 of the Articles of Association as proposed and announced by the Executive Board on 1 November 2023.

Furthermore, the General Meeting instructs and authorises the Executive Board to perform or to have performed all that is required to have the amendments executed before a Dutch civil law notary."
