IPv4 Run Out


- RIPE NCC reached the final /8 on September 14 2013:
 - All new and existing members can get one allocation
 - One size: /22 (1,024 addresses), even if you can justify a need for more
 - Only if you already have IPv6 addresses
 - No more PI assignments
- 1,250 allocations made so far

- Post depletion cleanup



Membership Growth





Members With and Without IPv6




IPv6 RIPEness



IPv6 RIPEness Denmark - One Year Ago




IPv6 RIPEness Denmark - Today

RIPE Atlas




RIPE Atlas

- 2,700 active probes
 - Working on next generation of probes
- First 10 RIPE Atlas anchors deployed
 - Act as regional targets for measurements
- APIs to interact with the system
 - Under development
- One-off measurements
 - Allow for immediate, one-time measurements


RIPEstat
