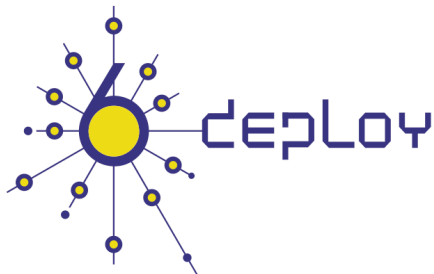

Our Experience

- We have deployed IPv6 in many networks
- Different types of networks
- Different size
- Most of them dual-stack
- Security always a concern, the same as when deploying IPv4
- In general, it was not difficult
 - Most of the problems due to lack of hardware readiness
 - Always alternative workaround

Special Cases (I)

- Some “big” networks
- Recent Example a complete country:
 - Cost Rica
 - Complex case because the broad mix of access technologies
 - Really easy in the backbone (MPLS)

Special Cases (II)

- Catalonian Schools
- 5.000 networks -> IPv6-only
 - Backbone and access are only IPv6
 - Local Area Networks are dual-stack
