

Income Development




RIPE NCC Fee Income (in EUR)


Budget and Forecast OPEX vs Member Development



Efficiency Remains Crucial









- Positive trend continued

One LIR One Fee







- The current equality between LIRs and additional LIRs has always been a strength in terms of predictability of income and simplicity for daily operations
- For next year, we want to look into opportunities to enhance the robustness and efficiency of our financial administration

Guiding Principles



Principles behind fee model RIPE NCC	Existing charging scheme "One LIR account one fee"
1) Equality between members	
2) Best match to the organisational governance	
3) Simplest model	
4) Sufficient to operate soundly (1 year)	
5) Sufficient to operate continuously (5 years)	

Proposal



- No change from Charging Scheme 2020
 - Service fee EUR 1,400
 - Sign-up fee EUR 2,000
 - Independent number resource assignment EUR 50
