- do nothing
 - remaining options are not exclusive
- abuse address in each inetnum etc
- abuse role in inetnum
- attach IRT to each inetnum
 - or neo-IRT not needing AUTH PGP
- change default whois output

- Requires abuse entries in RIPE DB
- Must not insist on Web submission of abuse reports
- Minor cosmetic changes
