### RIPE Cooperation Working Group

- A forum for discussion focusing on cooperation between the private and public sectors (government and law enforcement) on Internet matters
- Facilitates the RIPE community reaching common positions on public sector-related issues

#### History

- RIPE Enhanced Cooperation Task Force
  - Launched in 2007 in response to WSIS/IGF calls for "Enhanced Cooperation"
  - Produced a RIPE Document on Enhanced
     Cooperation, and proposed the establishment of this
     Working Group
- RIPE Cooperation Working Group launched in 2008
  - Has met twice at RIPE 57 and RIPE 58



## RIPE Cooperation Working Group

- Meets twice a year at RIPE Meetings
  - All stakeholders are invited to attend, take part in discussions, and give presentations
  - All proceedings are webcast and archived and anyone not on-site can join in the discussion via online chat!
