Key events:

- Internet Governance Forum 2018 in Paris
 - Included speech by President Macron supporting Internet regulation
- ITU Plenipotentiary 2018
- Discussions in UN General Assembly
 - Included formation of High-Level Panel on Digital Cooperation, new cybersecurity-related groups

Internet Governance in 2018



- Global Internet governance remains fragmented, uncertain
- Key stakeholders seem dissatisfied with status quo
 - Including governments, technical community, business sector
- Internet governance issues increasingly gaining mainstream attention

Key events (in Europe)

- Internet Governance Forum 2019, 25-29 November, Berlin
- EuroDIG, 18-19 June, The Hague
- An increasing number of national and regional events, many very successfully
 - SEEDIG (South East Europe), Central Asia IGF, APrIGF (Asia Pacific)
