

- Independent, not-for-profit, bottom-up membership organisation
- Anyone can become a member
- Incorporated in the Netherlands, governed by Dutch law
- Funded by members, fully autonomous
- Open, transparent, neutral and impartial
- Offices in Amsterdam, Dubai and Moscow
 - Around 130 staff members
 - 4 staff based in Dubai, 2 based in Moscow



- Allocating IP addresses and ASNs to members across our service region
- Facilitating bottom-up policy development process in our region
- Technical coordination to support a stable and reliable Internet
 - K-root
 - Measurements, statistics and analysis
 - Training and outreach




 We still have IPv4 addresses left - more than a /8 in the available pool

- Every member can get 1,024 addresses (/22)
- Block reserved for Internet Exchange Points
- Result of the "Last /8 policy", ensuring a supply of small blocks for future networks
- Recently received additional IPv4 space from IANA
 - "Returned space" allocated according to global policy
 - Each RIR received /12 (roughly 1 million addresses)





- Allocating from final /8 since March 2012
- Around 40% of membership have received /22
 - ~150 members each month
 - ~16,000 /22 in a single /8




Members Requesting IPv6 Addresses



- We can see the final /8 policy driving IPv6 allocations
 - But this doesn't necessarily translate to IPv6 services
