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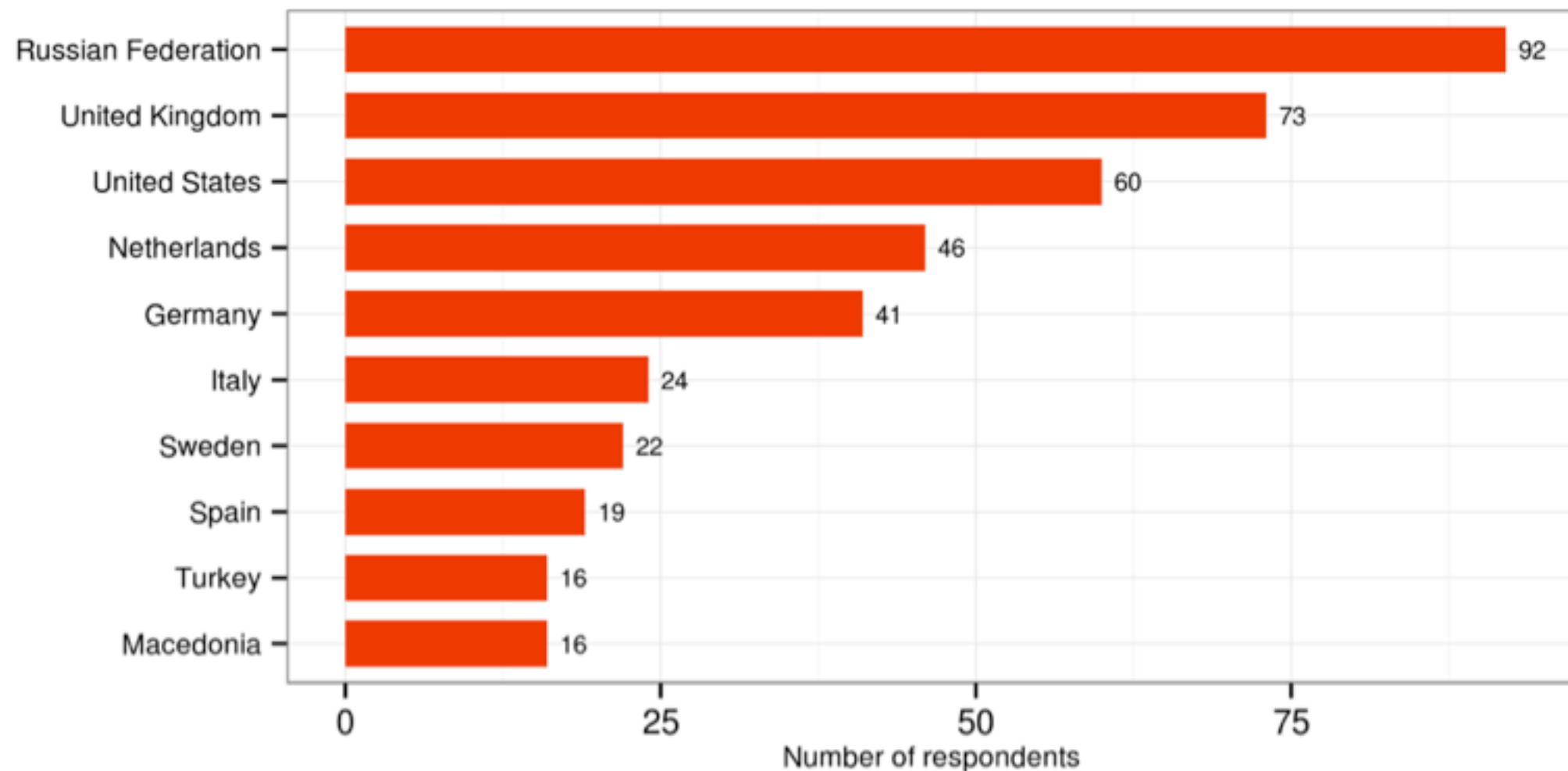
About the RIPE NCC Survey 2013

- The sixth large-scale RIPE NCC survey 2
 - Feedback from all stakeholders, including members government, law enforcement, etc.
 - Conducted by independent third party - the Oxford Internet Institute
- A huge response to the 2013 survey:
 - Over 3,500 responses (from 75 out of the 76 countries in our service region)
 - 2,919 RIPE NCC members
 - 712 other parties

- Distribution of non-member respondents

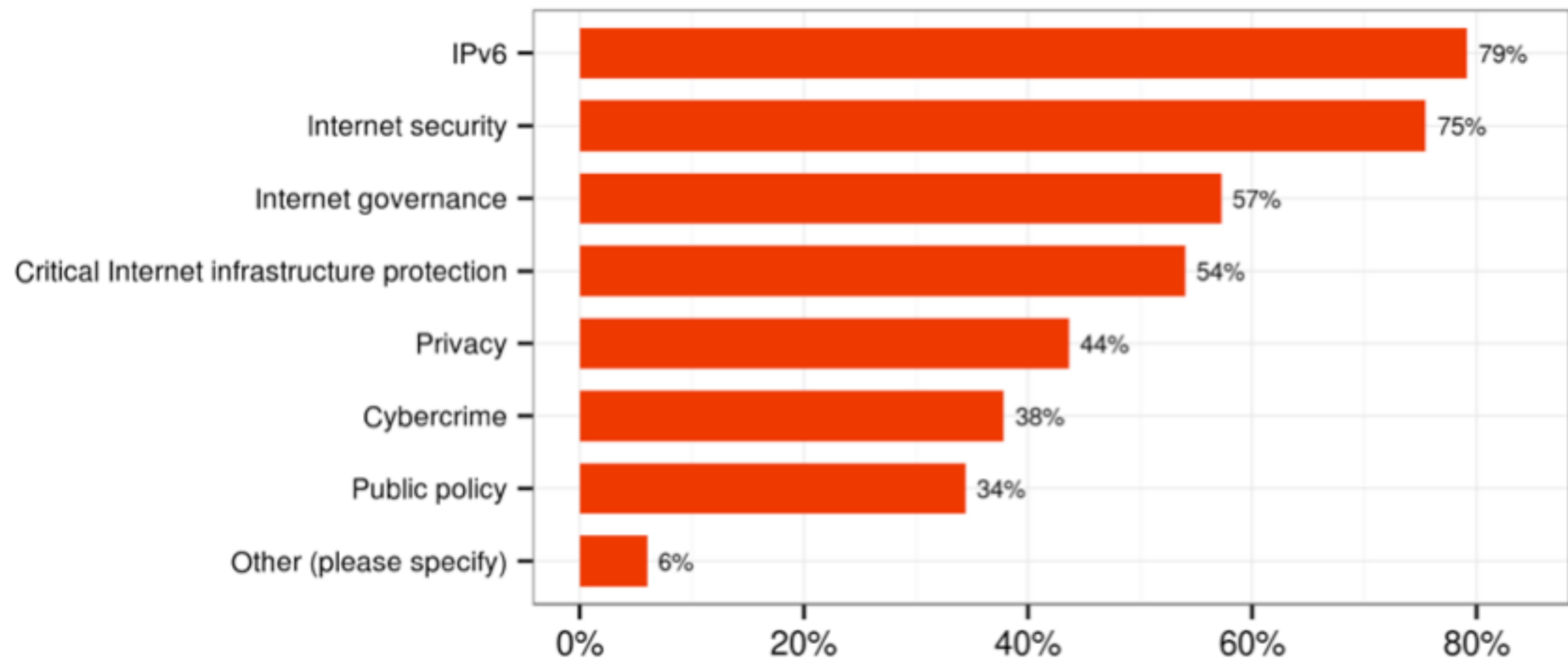
Non-member respondents per country (top 10)

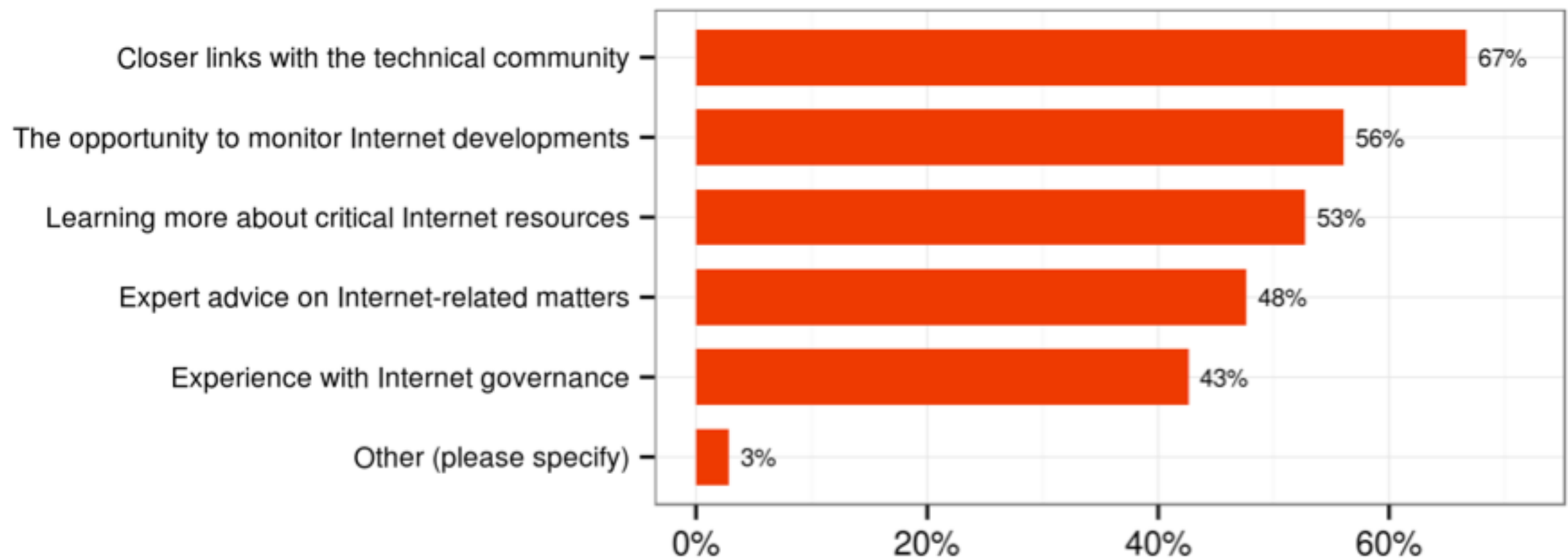
- Which of the following areas interest you?

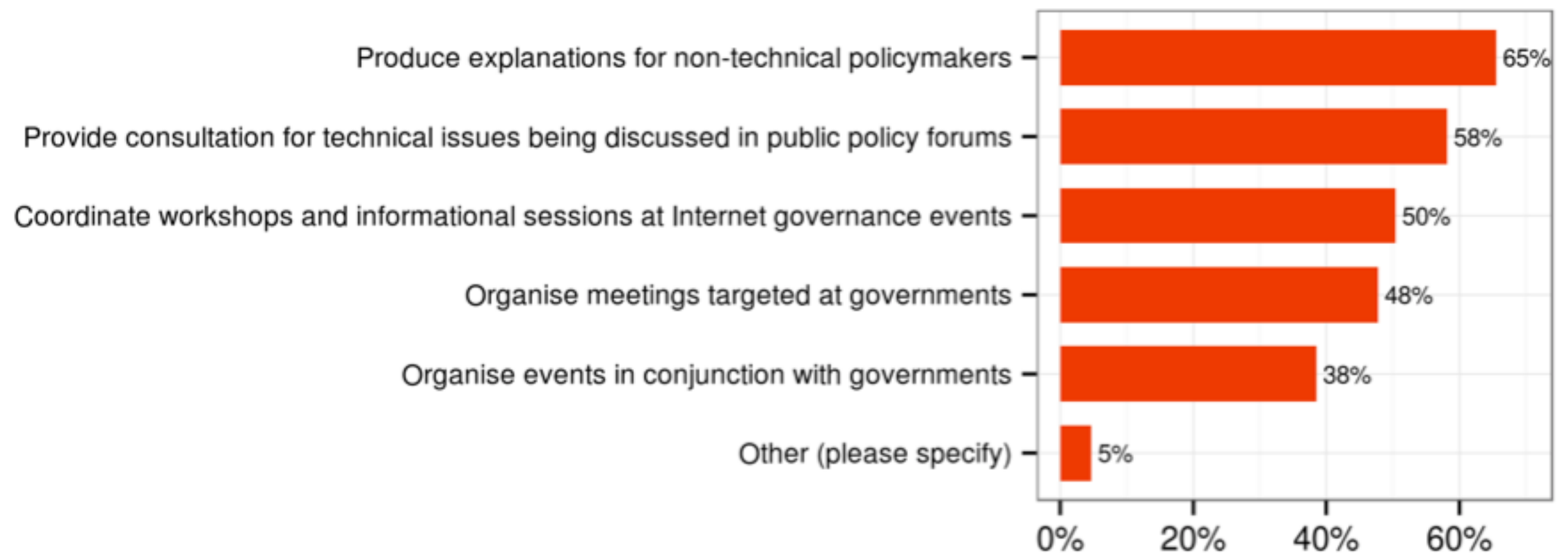
- What benefits do you see from engaging with the RIPE NCC?

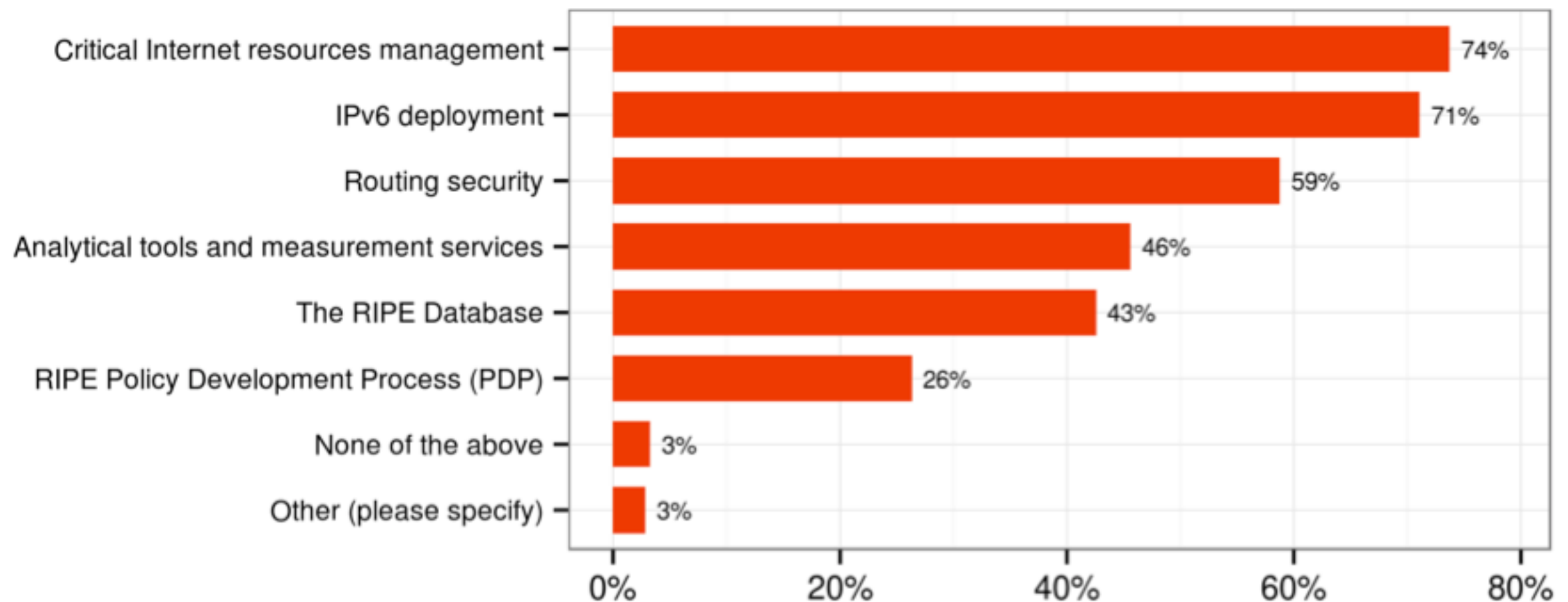
- What can the RIPE NCC do to improve outreach to government and regulators?

- In what areas should the RIPE NCC provide training courses for non-members?

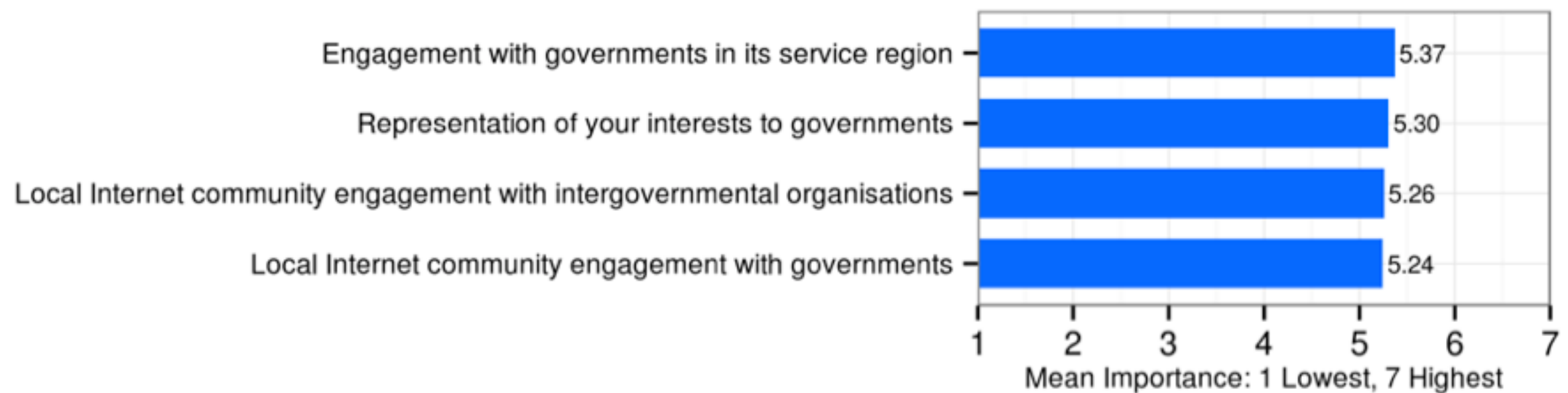

- Engagement with governments is seen as very important:

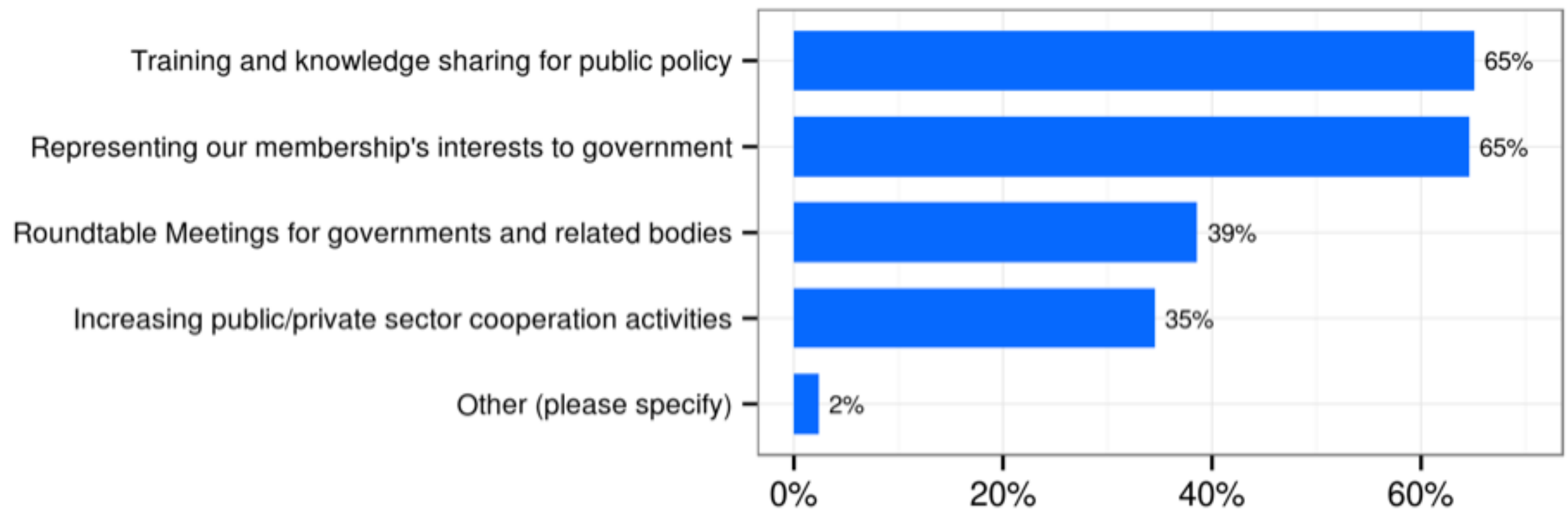
Please rate the importance level of the following from 1 to 7

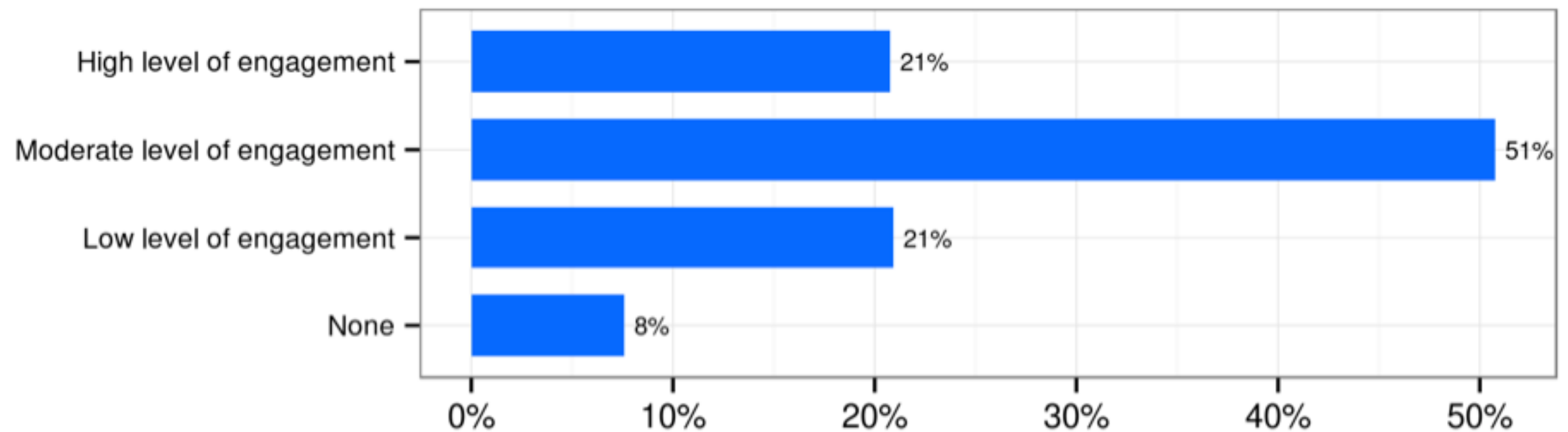
- Where should the the RIPE NCC allocate resources to better engage with governments?

Our Members' Perspective

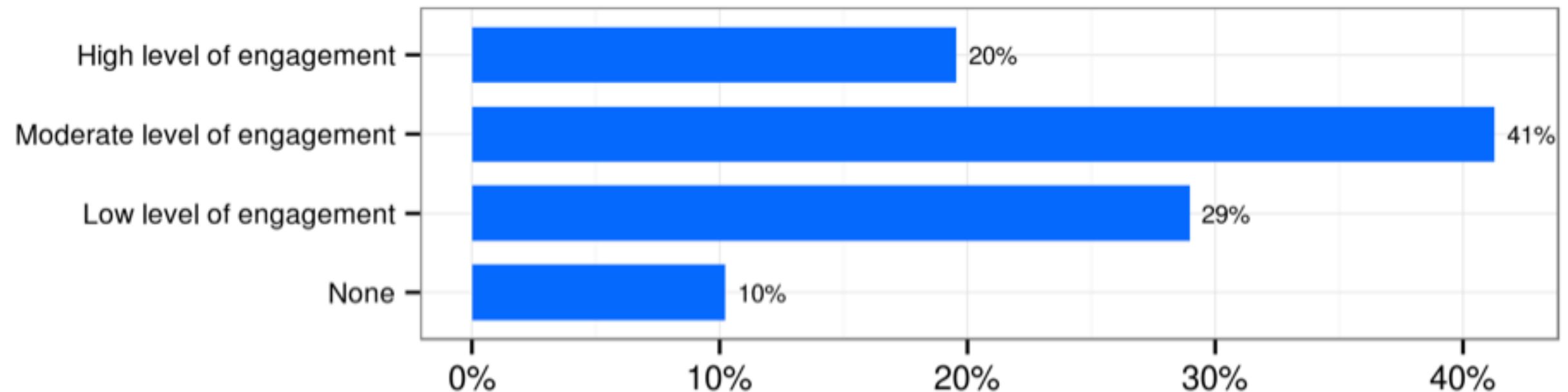
- How involved should the RIPE NCC be with governments?
