Not for profit membership organisation


5866 active members (1 sep 2008) 421 new members in 2008 (jan-aug)

One of five RIRs





Three views on the move to IPv6


Who needs IPv6? We have NAT!

#### IPv4 Address Pool - Now










### IPv6 Allocations by Region






## IPv6 Prefixes by Region
