





Voting on Resolutions



- There are three Resolutions to be voted on:
- Resolution 1 requires more than 50% YES votes to pass
- Resolution 2 requires more than 50% YES votes to pass
- Resolution 3 uses Instant Run-off voting (IRV)

Note: Abstentions are noted, but do not count!

Executive Board Election



- Six candidates to fill two seats
- Instant Run-off Voting will be used for the election
- Ranking candidates:
 - You must choose at least one candidate for a ballot to be considered or choose to abstain
 - You must number your candidates in order of preference

Instant Run-off Voting (IRV)





- In Instant Run-off Voting (IRV), voters rank candidates in order of preference.
- IRV is a preferential voting system where candidates have to receive >50% of top preference votes to be elected.
 - Rank Candidates: Voters rank candidates (1st, 2nd, 3rd, etc.)
 - Counting votes: In the first round, the 1st choice votes are counted. The first election winner is the candidate with >50% of 1st choice votes.
 - Elimination: If no candidate receives more than 50% in a round of voting, the candidate with the fewest top preference votes is eliminated.
 - Redistribution: The system then recalculates after redistributing votes according to the order of preference.
 - Repeat: This process continues until a candidate receives >50% of top preference votes.








Voting Code 1 is pre-filled

You will need Voting Code 2 (your GM Registration Number) to log in






Voting timer

If you leave the platform and return without completing the voting process, the timer will begin again.






Resolutions 1 and 2

You can choose Yes, No or Abstain.


You must choose one option to continue.






If you have several votes, you can assign them using the arrows for each selection.

Resolution 3


Uses Instant Run-off Voting

You can select from 1 to 3 options


Or choose to abstain






Again, if you have several votes, you can assign them using the arrows after each selection.

The Executive Board election


The election uses Instant Run-off Voting.

Choose at least one candidate or choose to abstain.






The Executive Board election

Click continue.






You will then be shown your voting selection for each resolution and the election.




You can track your ballot using the tracking code on the page or using the QR code.

Important Information



- You need to complete the entire voting process for your vote to be validated. If you leave the platform before casting your ballot, no votes will be registered.
- To receive the emails from Assembly Voting your email server needs to be TLS 1.2 compliant
- Tracking Pixel: There is a tracking pixel in the Assembly Voting emails. This
 is to track who has opened the voting emails. We only use this information
 to send the reminder email. Assembly Voting does not use this information
 for any other purpose.
- There are NO paper ballots at this GM.
