Through this correspondence, we are writing on behalf of the Regulatory Authority of Electronic and Postal Communications (ARKEP) of the Republic of Kosovo to formally request the definition of IP address space for Kosovo in the RIPE NCC database.

ARKEP is the national regulatory authority (NRA) responsible for overseeing the electronic communications market in the Republic of Kosovo, where internet services play a critical role in the economy. Our vision is to enhance the electronic communications sector in Kosovo and foster the development of the information economy by implementing policies that are aligned with European Union reforms and those of other industrialized nations. ARKEP is an active participant in various international institutions and organizations, including BEREC, CEPT ECC, ETSI, and others. Additionally, since 2016, the International Telecommunication Union (ITU) has allocated the country code +383 (including the Mobile Country Code) to the Republic of Kosovo. The prefix has also been officially registered under the code “.xk.”

We kindly request that RIPE NCC formally recognize Kosovo’s IP address space in its database to support the continued growth and development of the country's digital infrastructure.

We look forward to your positive response and are happy to provide any additional information or clarification as needed.
