



## Memorandum of Understanding Between Réseaux JP Européens Network Coordination Centre and Georgian National Communications Commission On Prontoting Internet Coordination Activities

Réseaux IP Européens Network Coordination Centre (RIPE NCC) and Georgian National Communications Commission (GNCC),

hereinafter collectively referred to as "Parties",

whereas the RIPE NCC is a non-for-profit association and has as an objective to perform coordination activities for the support of the stable operation of the Internet,

whereas the Georgian National Communications Commission has a strong interest in the Internet coordination activities as well as in the stable Internet operations related to Georgia

whereas the Parties wish to commit to an ongoing collaboration for the promotion of Internet coordination activities for stable Internet operations in Georgia,

have an understanding that for the purposes of this collaboration:

- 1) The Parties will cooperate on IPv6 development, including organising and hosting relevant training courses and IPv6 Roadshow.
- 2) The Parties will promote the RIPE Academic Cooperation Initiative to Georgian academic community so that the latter takes part and benefits from it.
- 3) The Parties will promote RIPE Atlas in order to provide more Internet analytical tools and data for local and global communities.

This Memorandum and the collaboration described are independent from other collaboration efforts the RIPE NCC may under take or commit to in Georgia.

The Parties hereby acknowledge and agree that this Memorandum is non-binding and does not create any obligations under law

This Memorandum may be amended upon agreement by both parties at any time.
