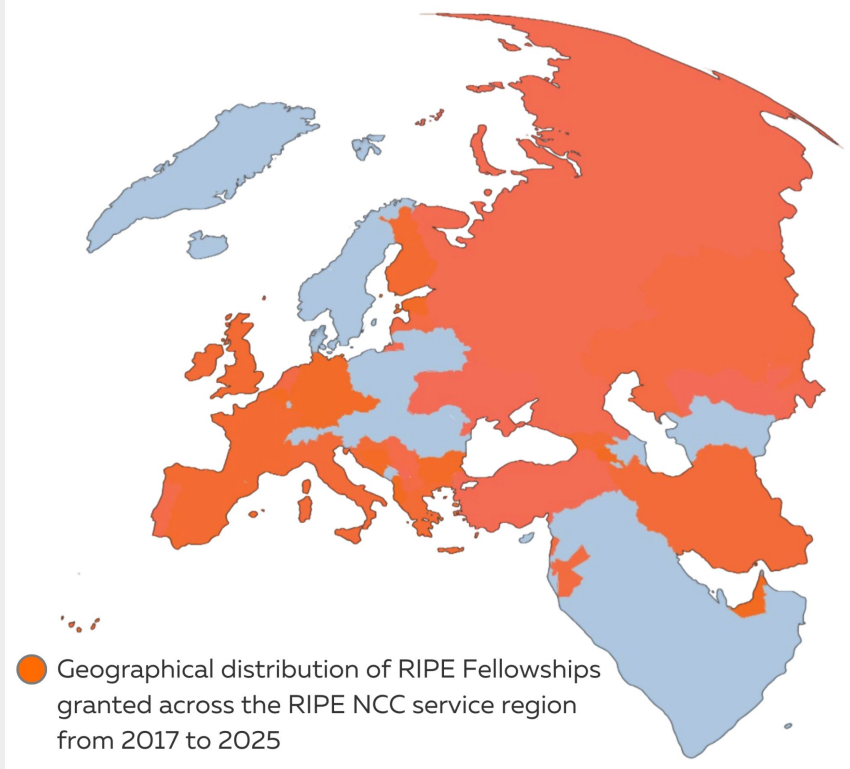

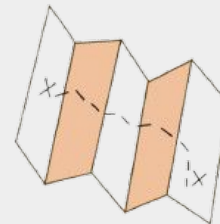

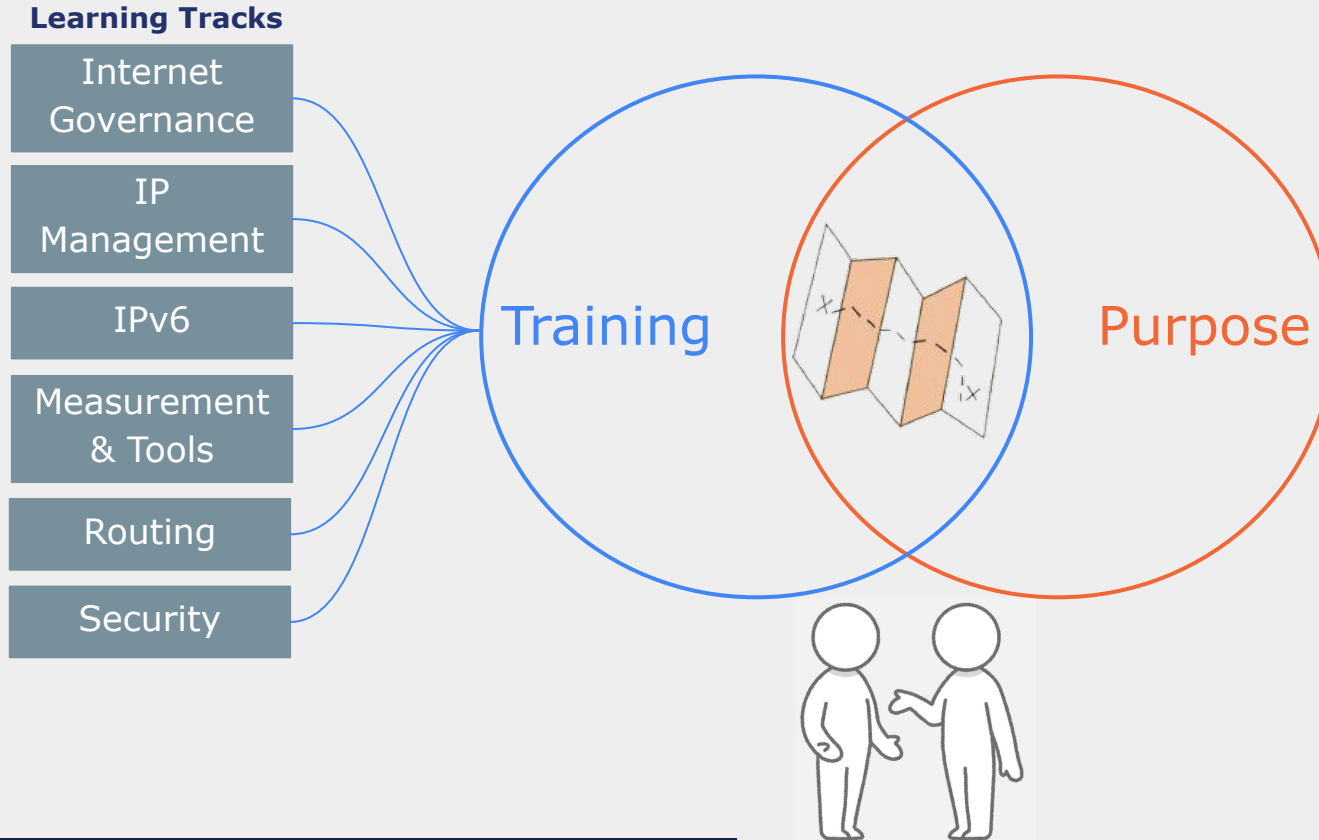

Personal Learning Path



The RIPE Fellow Coach



- **Inspired by the RIPE Mentoring programme.**
- Helps Fellows design & progress in their Personal Learning Path, navigate the RIPE landscape, and gain confidence.



How?

- Select the Fellows - optional
- Three 1:1 calls per Fellow
- Activities at the RIPE meeting (virtual or onsite)

Time commitment:

- Max 8 hours pre-meeting
- ~2 hours during the RIPE Meeting

Core Differences: Old & New Design



	Old Design	New Design
Goal	• Bring diversity of voices • Remove financial barrier to attend	Make sure new diverse voices stay & engage with the community
Duration	1 week	4 months
Structured Support	Limited	RIPE Fellow Coach
Phases	Just one: Attend the RIPE meeting	Three: Before, At & After
Key Elements	Trip & Full ticket to the meeting	• Set clear expectations: pre-application 101 webinar & Quiz • Adapt to individual interests: Personal Learning Path • Coaching • Training in Public Speaking • Trip & Full Ticket to the meeting • Satisfaction survey and mailing list

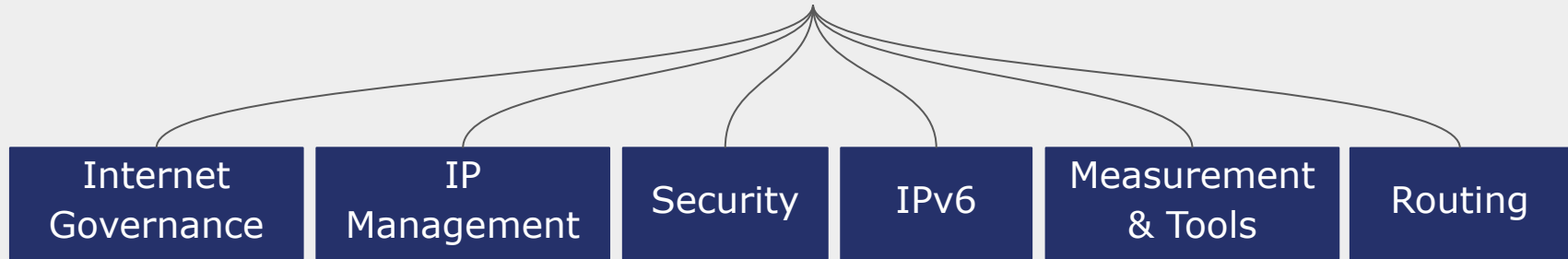

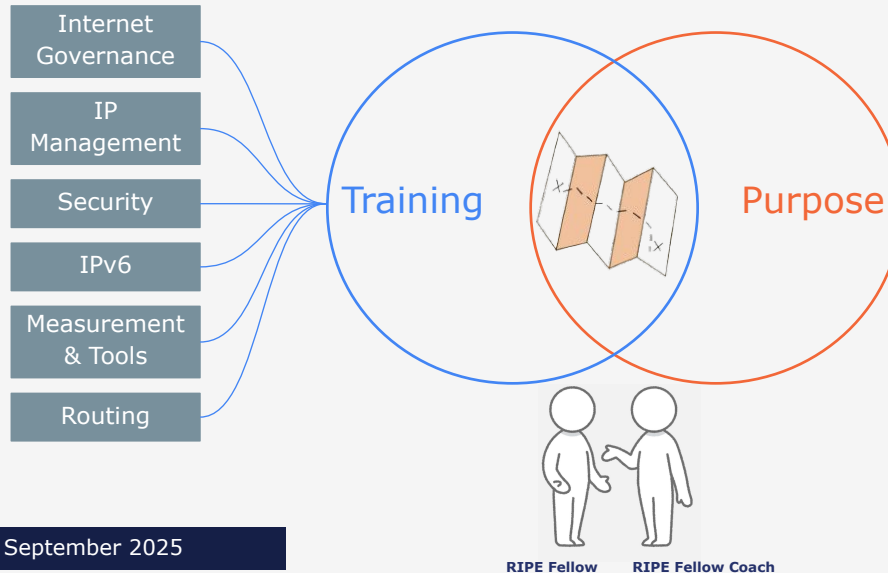
What is your opinion about the #6 Learning Tracks?

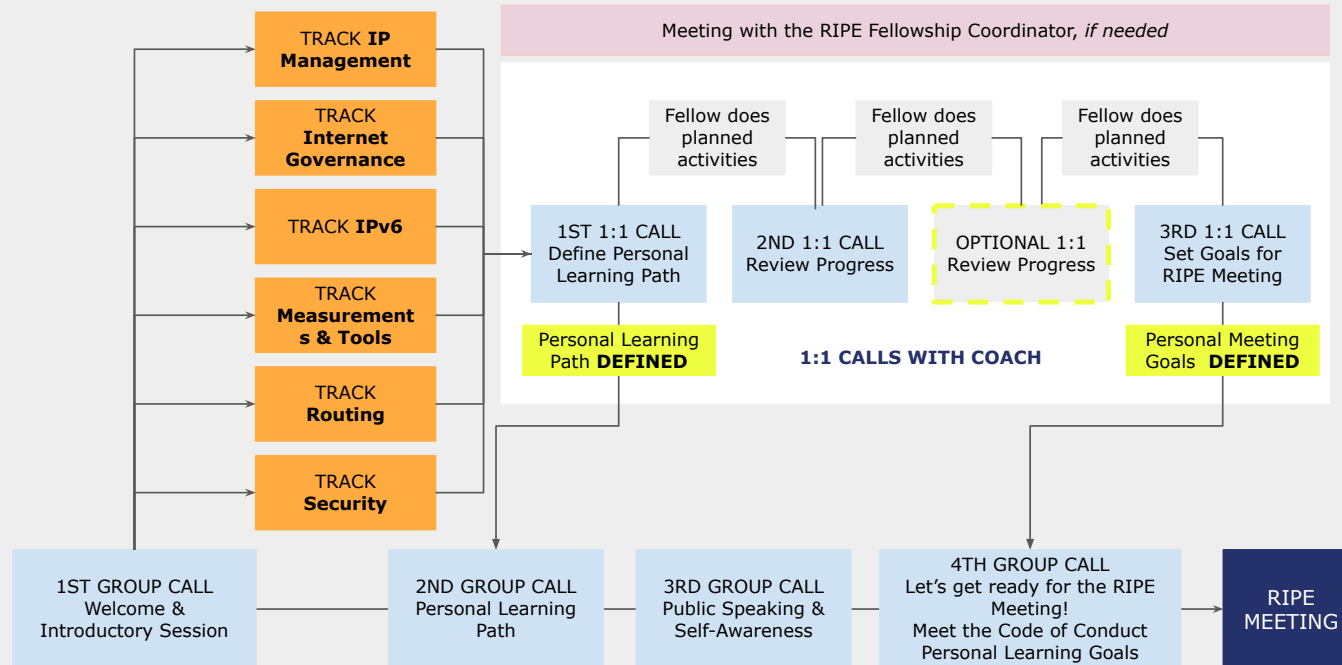
