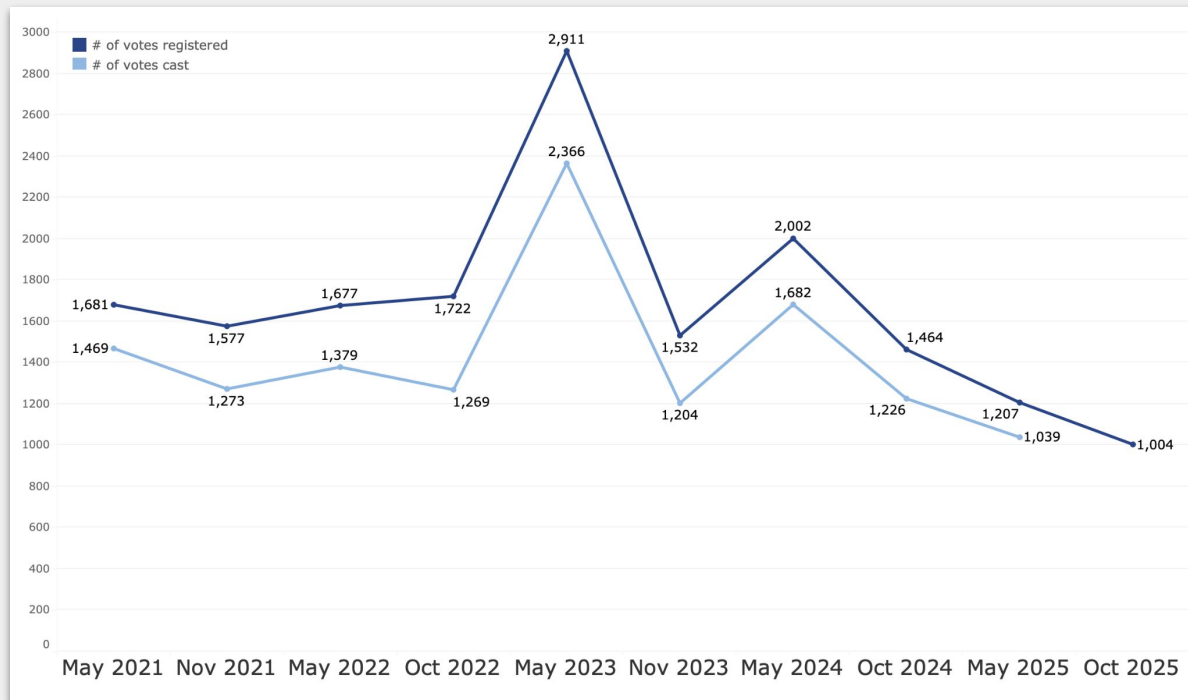
**In line with the Articles of Association,

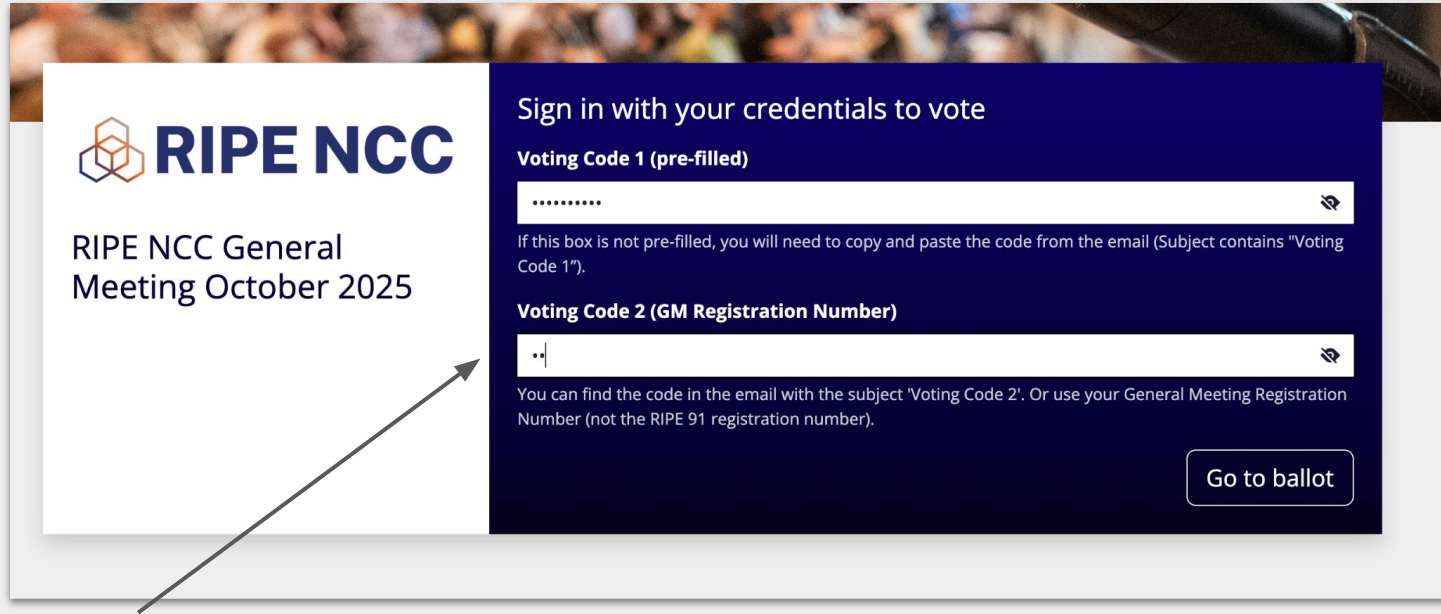

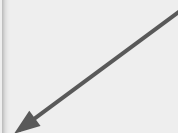

To receive the emails from Assembly Voting, your email server needs to be **TLS 1.2 compliant**.

The **tracking pixel** in Assembly Voting emails records who opens the voting emails. This information is used only to send reminder emails to those who haven't opened them.
