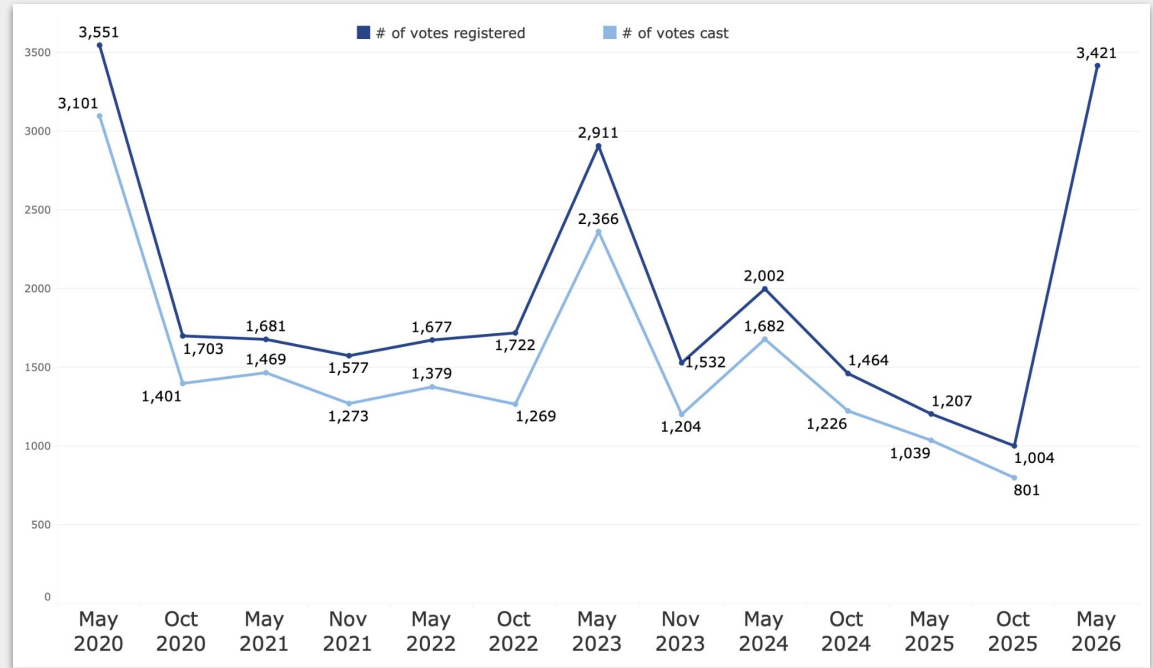
**In line with the Articles of Association,

Voting on the resolutions



There are **three** resolutions to vote on

Resolutions **1 and 2** require more than 50% YES votes to be approved

The options in **Resolution 3** (charging scheme vote) require more than 50% of the votes to be approved

Abstentions are noted, but **do not** count towards the result!



Executive Board Election

Executive Board Election



There are **FIVE** candidates to fill **THREE** seats

- **Instant run-off voting** will be used for the election
- You must **choose at least one candidate** for your vote to be counted
- Or abstain from the vote
- Number the candidates in order of preference
- You do not need to number every candidate
- Abstentions are noted but do not count towards the result



Instant run-off voting

- Voters rank candidates in order of preference (1st choice, 2nd choice, etc.)
- If a candidate gets more than 50% of the 1st choice votes, they are elected to the first seat
- If no one gets 50%, the candidate with the fewest votes is eliminated
- Votes for the eliminated candidate are reassigned to the voter's next choice
- This process repeats until one candidate has a majority (over 50%) and is elected to the second seat, and so on



Please check your **spam** for the Assembly Voting emails

If you are using **Safari**, the pre-filled code (Voting Code 1) might not appear. You will need to copy/paste it from the email containing the link to the voting platform

To receive the emails from Assembly Voting, your email server needs to be **TLS 1.2 compliant**

The **tracking pixel** in Assembly Voting emails records who opens the voting emails. This information is used only to send reminder emails to those who haven't opened them
