Newcomer Programs: Goals and Objectives



Fellowship

Global capacity development program to support ICANN's multistakeholder community; online application process is open three times per year to participate in an ICANN Public Meeting.



NextGen

Regionally based program to create awareness and promote future discussions within universities and other regional forums; online application process is open three times per year to attend an ICANN Public Meeting.



Beginners

Program dedicated to those entering the ICANN community. Options are self-study using the ICANN For Beginners web page or participation in person or remotely at an ICANN Public Meeting.

Beginners

No funding offered, but opens doors to communication and learning through ICANN Learn, other resources, and engagement@icann.org

Fellowship Program | At-a-glance

- ⦿ Fosters opportunities for individuals from underserved and underrepresented communities to become active participants
- ⦿ Online application process happens three times per year (for each ICANN meeting), but the Policy Forum is for alumni only
- ⦿ Up to 40 fellows are selected for each round; 5 mentors are appointed by SOs/ACs
- ⦿ Important source for identifying potential active new community participants and in further honing the skills of returning program participants

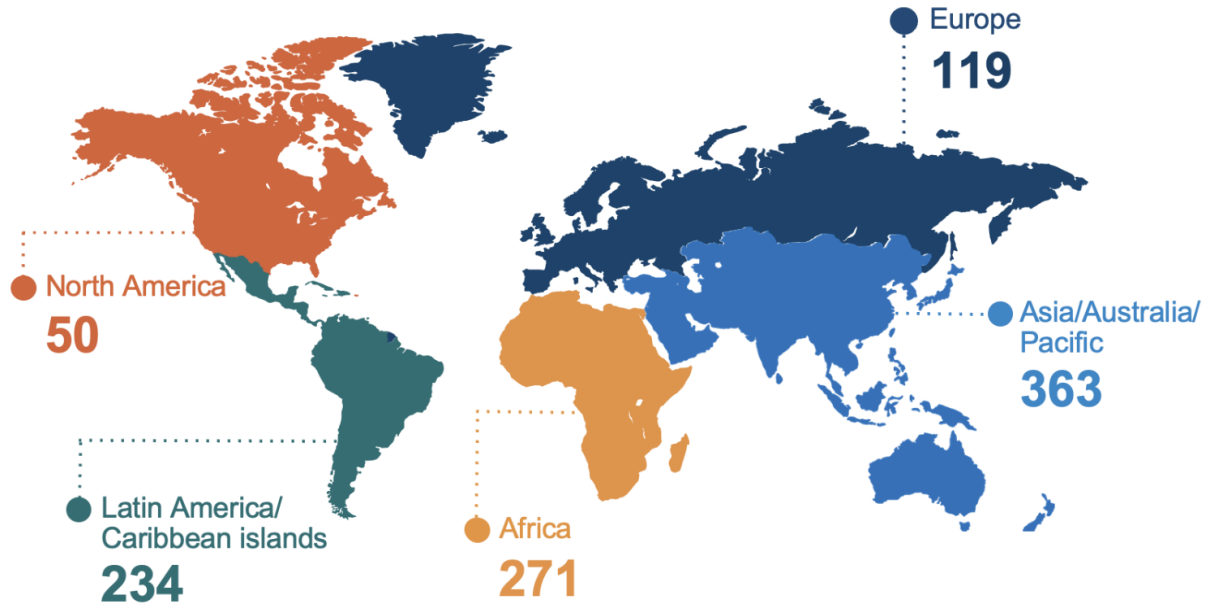


Fellowship Program | Statistics

NextGen@ICANN Program | At-a-glance

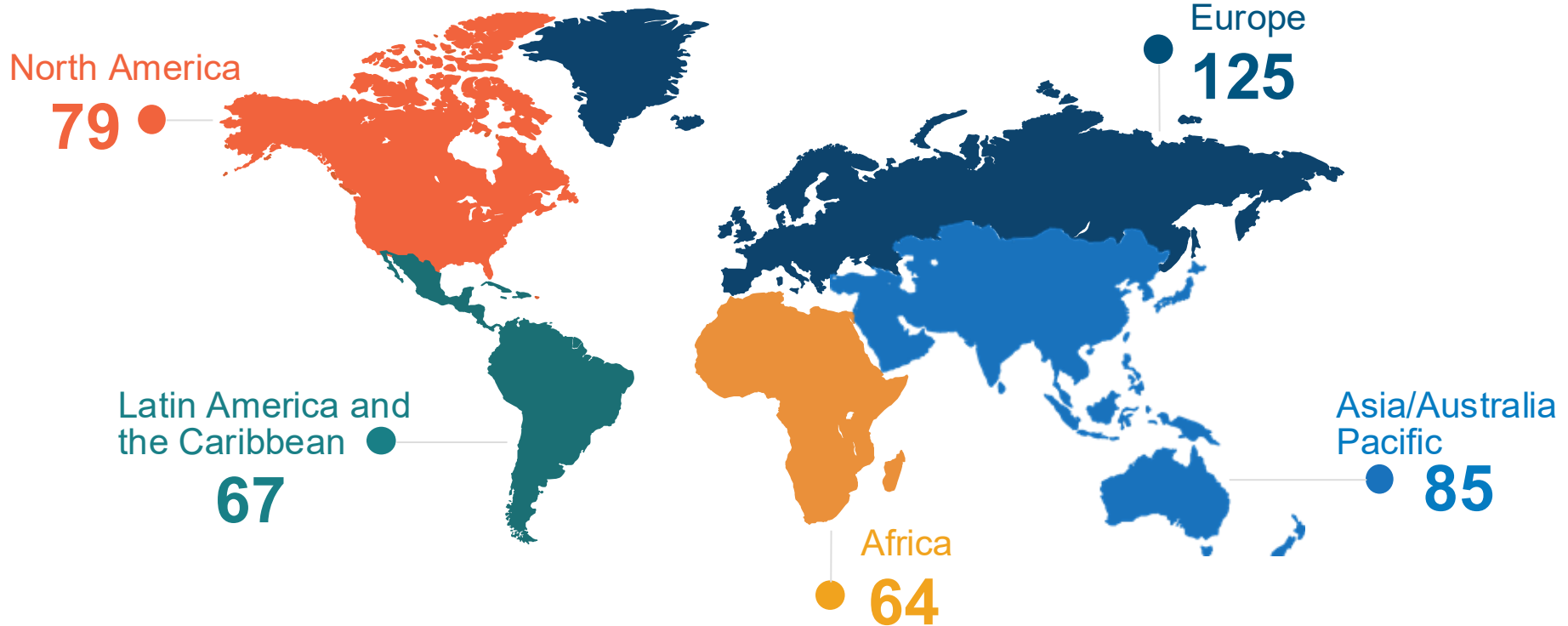
- Key source for identifying new ICANN community participants

- Participants encouraged to share ICANN information and insights



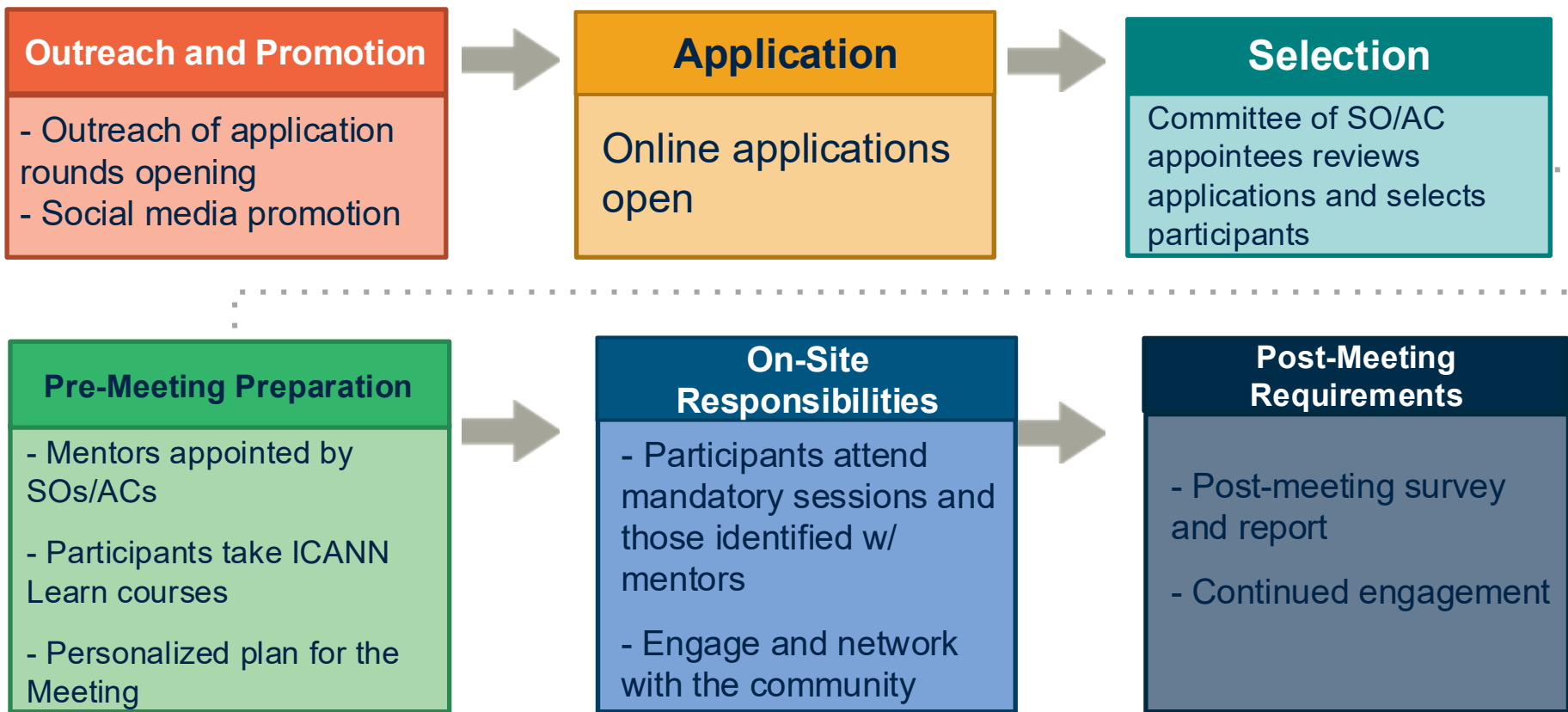
NextGen@ICANN Program | Statistics

Fellowship Program

- Focuses on global capacity development to support representation and active involvement in ICANN's multistakeholder community
- 21+ years old from underserved and underrepresented communities

NextGen@ICANN Program

- Focuses on education, awareness and future engagement and invites the next generation to engage with ICANN
- 18–30-year-old students from the region where the ICANN meeting is taking place
