

# **2000s: Liberalisation and Privatisation**

- EU accession process played a key role
- New players entering the market
- Increased foreign investment
- Strengthening of independent regulatory authorities

# 2010s: Market Characteristics and Trends

- Increased competition (MVNOs and OTTs)
- Change in consumer behaviours and preferences (mobile data) as a key driver of growth)
- Growing demand for high-speed Internet
- Changes in regulatory environment (customer focused)

# Market Response

- Restructuring of telecom companies (divestitures like spin-offs) and carved-outs, outsourcing, mergers and acquisitions)
- Convergence and vertical integration
- Expansion of 5G and fibre optic network
- Market consolidation






Median Country Speeds in Mbps Source: <u>speedtest.net</u>








# **Market Share by Number of Subscribers**

# **5G Frequency Allocation**

- Bulgaria secure licences
- Complaint stating unlawfully terminated auction to Bulgarian Supreme Administrative Court (SAC) filed by Mobile Alternative Communications (MAC) in 2023
- MAC seeks to create an alternative mobile operator, proposing opening of current operators networks
- Court rules in MAC's favour, public consultations must be resumed


