- IPv4
 - Received 3 /8s in August 2006
 - 77.0.0.0/8 and 78.0.0.0/7
- Finally: IPv6 Global Policy Adopted
 - IANA allocates /12 blocks to RIRs
 - 2a00::/12 for RIPE NCC

 - (2006-04) Contact e-mail Address Requirements
 - (2006-05) PI Assignment Size
 - (2006-06) IPv4 Maximum Allocation Period
 - (2006-07) Minimum IPv4 Assignment Window

32 bit AS Numbers... (Early Warning)

- 32 bit AS Number Policy (2005-12)
 - Work on preparation for 1 January 2007 is underway
 - Lots of systems affected
- 2007: RIPE NCC able to assign 32 bit AS Numbers (ASN32)
- 2009: Default will be an ASN32
- Get one and check how this will affect your systems
- Our experience: Changing a 16 bit number into a 32 bit number is a non-trivial operation that requires a lot more time than one would think.

Speaking about Governance...


- What happened to "Internet Governance"?
