 2020: Joint representation from two to four members Article 10 – Executive Board: Authority and Representation 10.4 The authority to represent the Association shall be vested in the Executive Board. Two members of the Executive Board, acting jointly, shall also be authorised to represent the Association.

Article 10 – Executive Board: Authority and Representation 10.4 The authority to represent the Association shall be vested in the Executive Board. *Four* members of the Executive Board, acting jointly, shall also be authorised to represent the Association.



the written support of at least five Members

- a certified copy of an official identification document
- · a signed statement that declares
- adherence to the CoC for Candidates, and
- that he/she never committed fraud or other financial misconduct in any jurisdiction







Extra Criteria for EB Candidates



Proposed Article 9.1(c)

- A board member of another RIR, ICANN or ISOC; and
- A member of the ASO AC.




Proposed Article 9.1(d)

Nominees must sign a statement in which they declare:

- the legal entity they are an employee of and the Affiliates of this legal entity,
- the legal entities they are a significant shareholder of and the Affiliates of these legal entities and
- the partnerships they are a member of or employee of.

























Proposed amendments to Article 18.2






Nominees must sign a statement where they declare that they are not:

- Employed by the same legal entity or affiliate as an Executive Board member.
- A significant shareholder of the same legal entity or affiliate as an Executive Board member.

Statement no longer true because of 1st seat winner
















Proposed amendments to Article 9.8

Additional reason for ending the EB membership:

If the documents submitted by an EB member to become candidates are proven to be falsified or containing false information

Proposed amendments to Article 9.8

Nominees must sign a statement where they declare that they are not:

- Nominees must sign a statement in which they declare:
- the legal entity they are an employee of and the Affiliates of this legal entity,
- the companies they are a significant shareholder of and the Affiliates of these companies and
- the partnerships they are a member of or employee of.

- A MeMber of the ASO AC.



Proposed amendments to Article 9.8

- Nominees must sign a statement in which they declare:
 - the legal entity they are an employee of and the Affiliates of this legal entity.

- Certified copy of an official identification document
- A signed statement that declares:
 - Adherence to CoC for Candidates
 - They never committed fraud or other financial misconduct in any jurisdiction
