Registration Overview




- 16,751 eligible voters

Voting at the GM



- Two ways to vote at the GM:
 - -Paper ballot (attendees only)
 - -Electronically (remote participants and attendees)

The Resolutions



- Resolution 1 needs more than 50% of YES votes to be approved
- Resolutions 2, 3 and 4 need more than two-thirds of YES votes to be confirmed
- Abstentions are noted but do not affect the count

Counting the Votes



- We use the third party BigPulse system for voting
- •The paper ballots are stored in the hotel safe until 09:00 UTC+2 on Friday
- After the voting deadline passes, paper votes are added to the electronic votes in the BigPulse system
- Independent observers from the other RIRs oversee the input of paper ballots into the system
