Amendments to the AoA

Expansion of number of Board members

 Eliminate Board requirement to nominate a candidate in case of too few candidates

Simplification of the identification requirement for electronic voting



Expanding the number of Board members

- The Board proposes to increase the current maximum number of Board members from five to seven to:
 - Better reflect the changing composition of the RIPE NCC membership
 - Have more specialist knowledge available to the Board to handle specific areas
 - Better handle the increased responsibility for the Executive Board in representing a growing membership with more diverse concerns and issues



Expanding the number of Board members

- If the members approve this amendment, implementation would be in two steps:
 - one additional seat in May 2014 and one additional seat in May 2015

Elimination of nomination requirement

 If this requirement is removed, all power to nominate candidates would rest with the membership



Simplification of identification requirement

- Simplifying the identification procedure for electronic voting would make it easier to participate online
- Possible to set up "identification" through, for instance, the LIR Portal

Voting on the resolutions

- Last time there were changes to the AoA, members had to vote on all in one bundle
- Members asked that changes be voted on separately in case they approved of some and disapproved of others
- Members will vote on the three AoA resolutions separately
