How the Votes Are Counted (Elections)

A candidate needs more than 50% of the votes

The <u>first preference votes</u> are counted by the system

• If a candidate has more than 50% of the first preference votes, he is elected

How the Votes Are Counted (Election)

- If no candidate receives 50%, the candidate with the <u>least amount of first preference</u> votes is eliminated
- His votes are divided among the remaining candidates according to the <u>second</u>
 <u>preferences</u> and added to the remaining candidates' totals
- The system counts the votes again the candidate with more than 50% wins the seat



How the Votes Are Counted (Election)

 The winner of the first seat is removed from the second count and the process is repeated

 The candidate with more than 50% of the votes is elected to the second seat

The Vote Counting Process

- Electronic voting stays open until 14:00 (UTC +1)on Thursday, 16 May
- The paper votes are <u>then</u> entered into the system under supervision of independent scrutineers
- The system calculates the results from the total of electronic votes and paper ballots

Voting Period

- Voting period starts at agenda point 9
- Paper ballots must be handed in immediately
- Electronic voting remains open until 14:00 (UTC +1) on Thursday, 16 May
- Paper ballots are combined with the electronic votes
- Results unavailable until voting period closes
