 - Agreed on principles
 - Describe fully, publish and discuss over summer
 - Formal proposal for GM @ RIPE 63



Elements of future Charging Scheme

- Yardstick for members' benefit from RIPE NCC services
 - More operational involvement -> more benefit
- Be member if using member service
- Cost to members should
 - remain on similar level as now, generally
 - avoid extreme changes, individually
- Charging Scheme should be simple and changes be predictable
