Discussed Voting Procedures

- Initial intention: Postal Ballot
 - Surprisingly, not possible for associations
- Clear preference from members:
 - E-voting through LIR-portal

- Published Proposal:
 - "live e-voting" during specified period in GM
 - GM to be webcast to members
 - Intentions to extend for all resolutions, but want to review functionality



Discussed Charging Scheme

- Proposed Charging Scheme
 - Fixed fee per assignment
- Followed discussion
 - Fallback proposal increasing fees for all

- 2007-01 related work is imperative
 - Policy calls for contracts
 - Updating records
 - ...
