






# Registration Overview

# How to Vote



Voting can take place once the Chair declares voting open

- Voting is available to all members who have registered to vote electronically.
- Votes can be cast until 09:00 (UTC+1) on Friday, 1 December 2023.
- There are NO paper ballots at this GM.
- Important: You need to complete the whole voting process for your vote to be validated. If you leave the platform before casting your ballot, no votes will be registered.

To login to the voting platform, click on the "Vote Now" button below.


Please note that the voting platform will only be accessible when the Chair of the Executive Board opens the election at **approximately 18:00 UTC+1**.



# Voting on Resolutions
