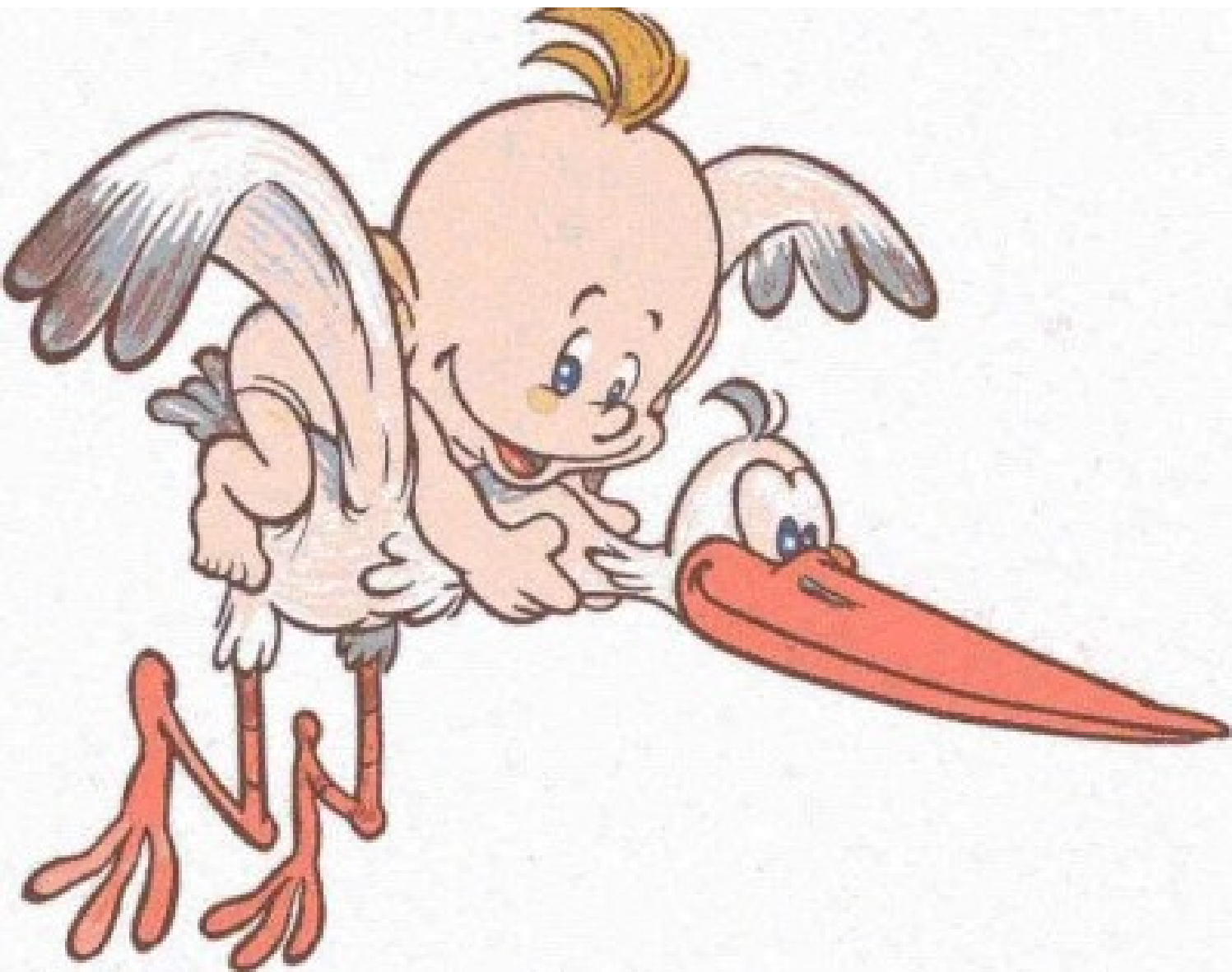

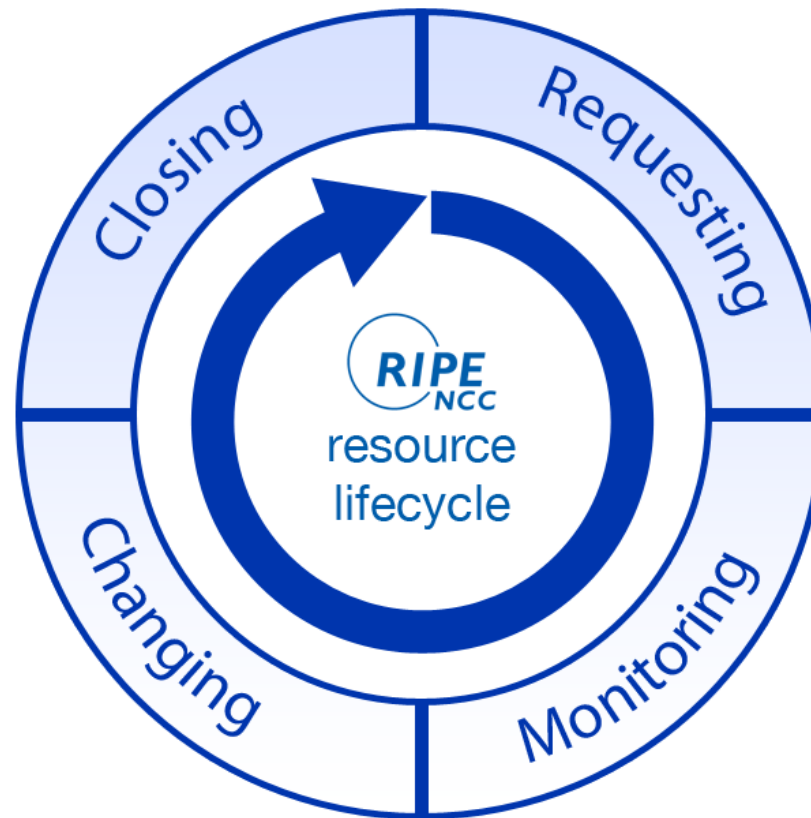
The RIPE NCC is not Santa Claus!

Resource Life Cycle Management

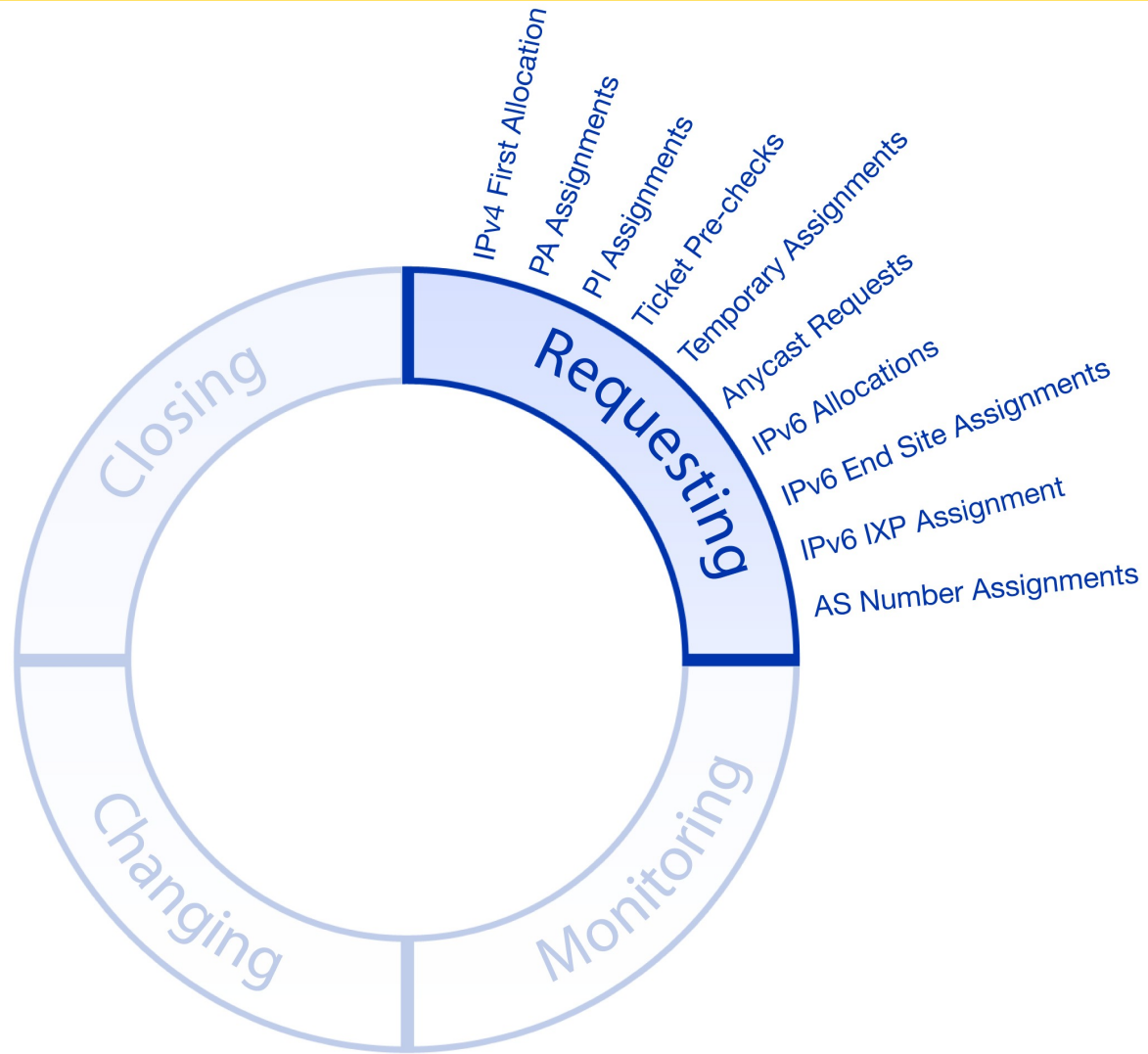
- There are four phases in the life cycle of an Internet number resource:

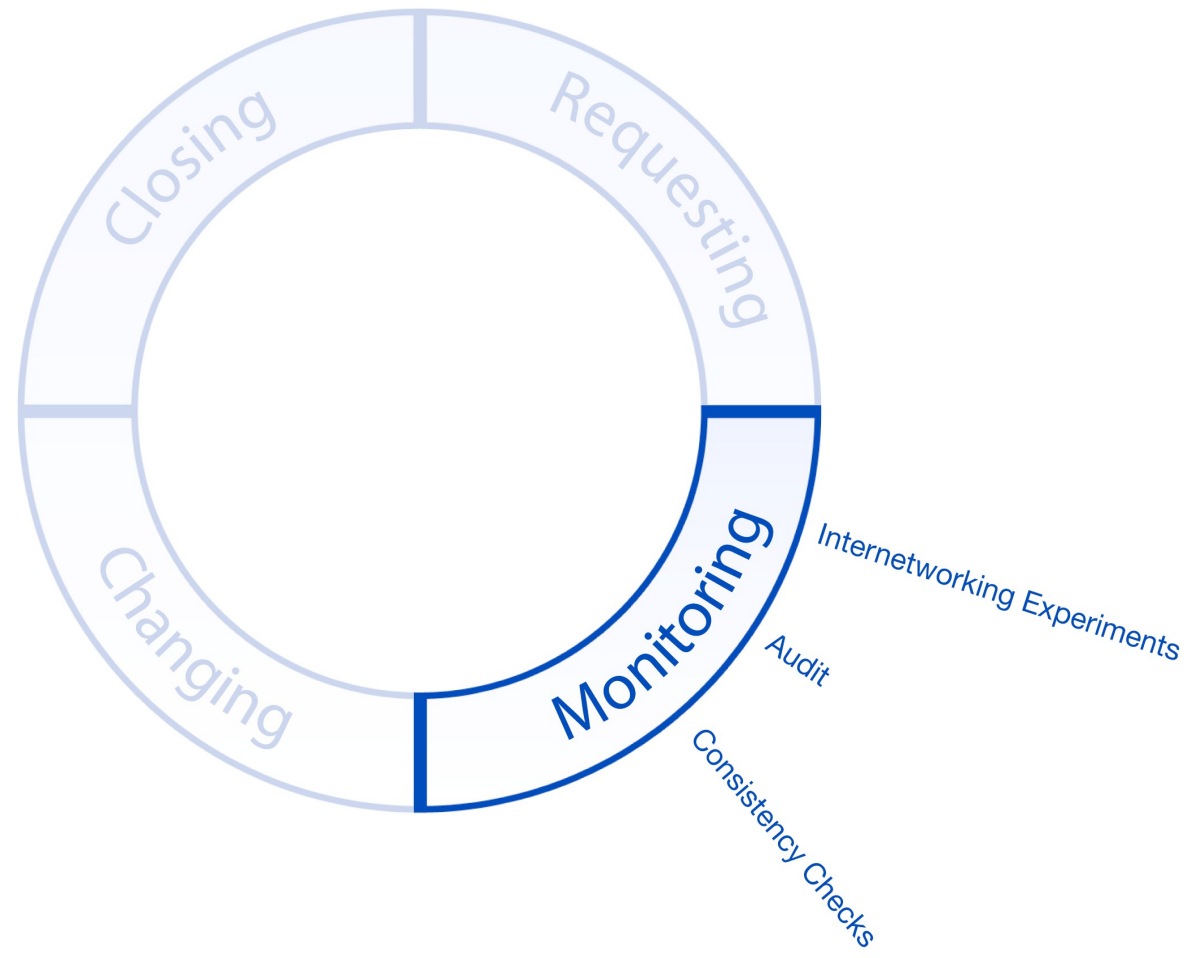


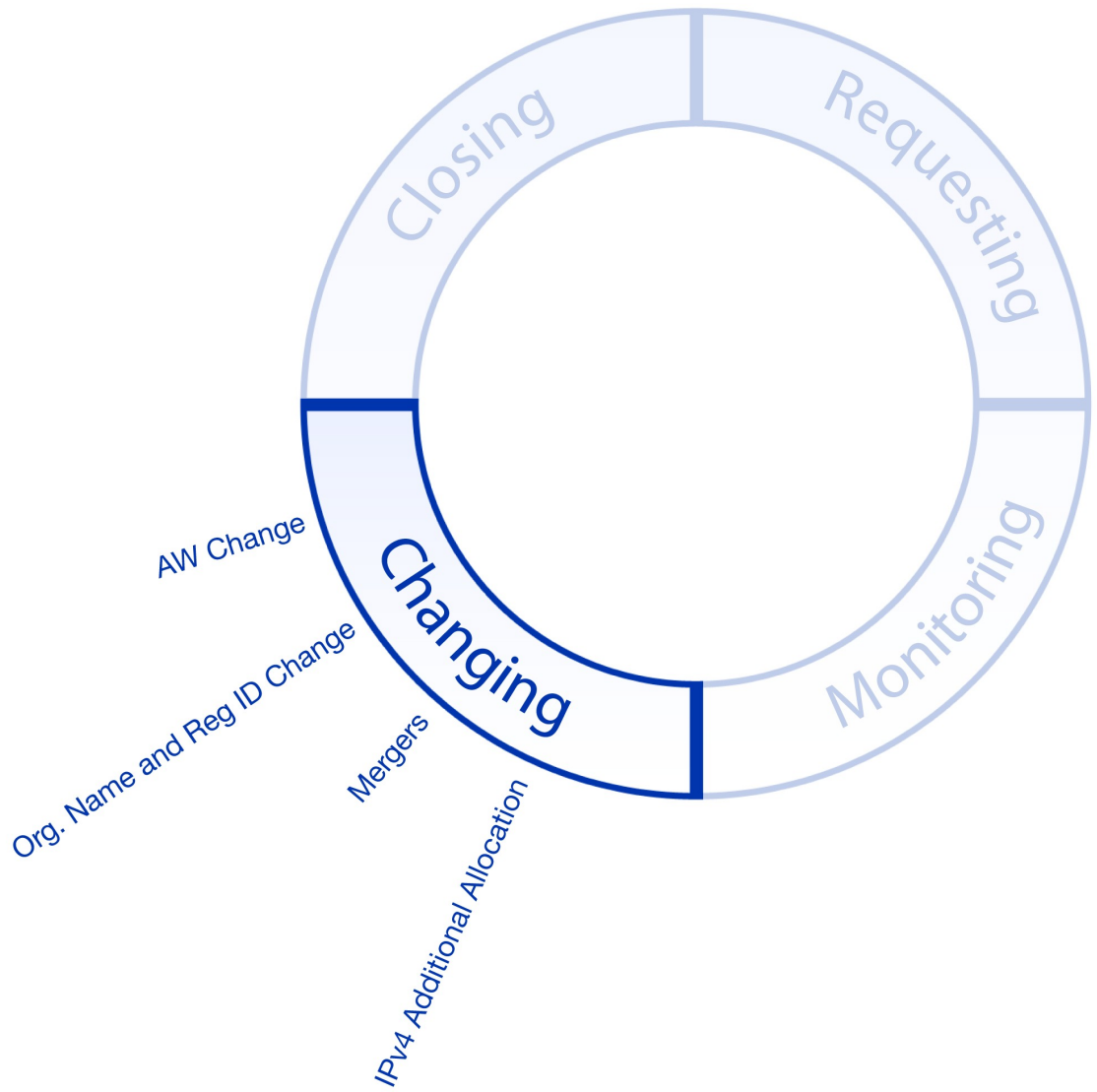


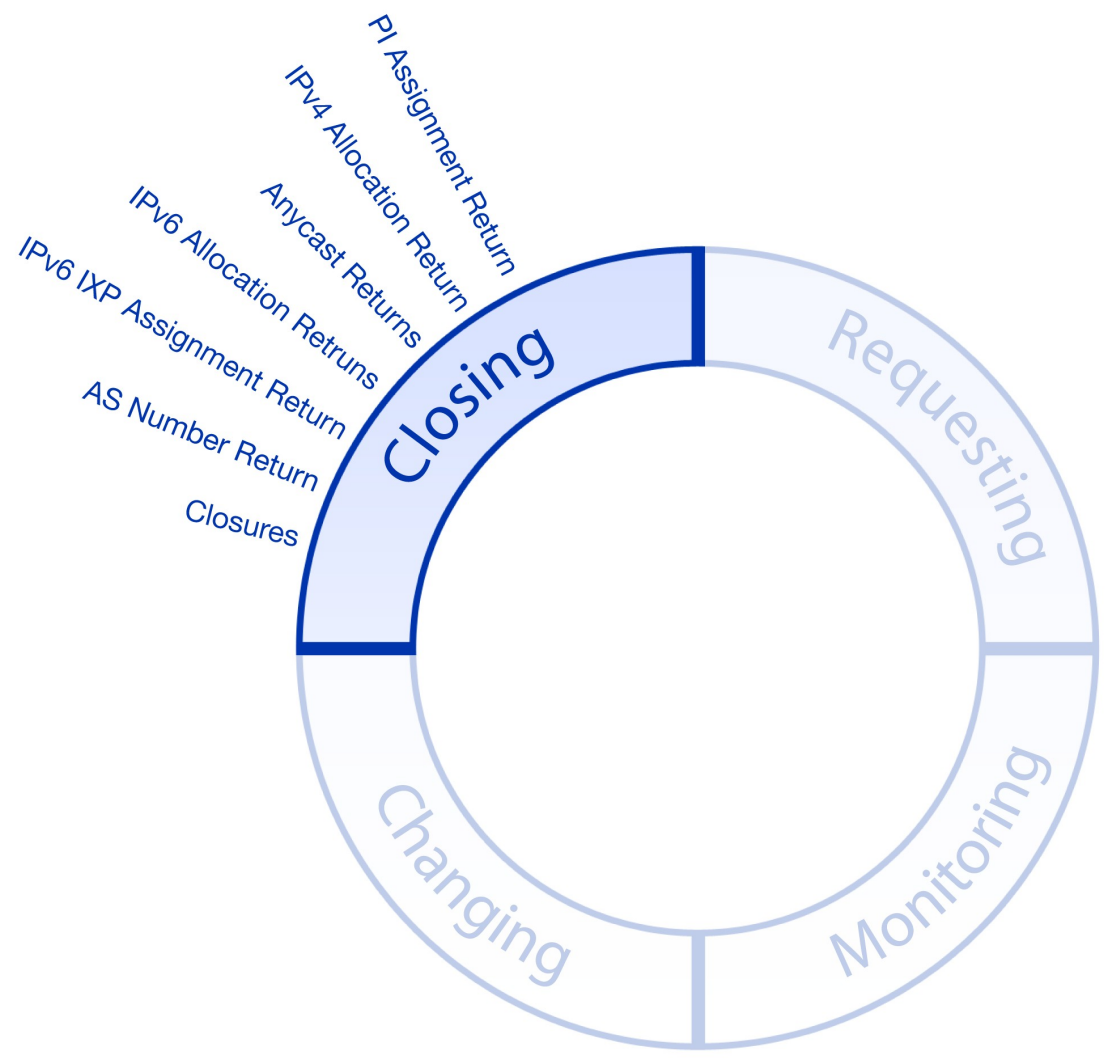
Resource Life Cycle Management (2)

- The RIPE NCC is neutral and impartial
- Each life cycle phase is based on policies determined by the RIPE community
- This ensures fairness and transparency











Resource Certification

- Resource Certification is an enhancement to resource life cycle management
- The free pool of IPv4 is running out, which means:
 - A possible growth in demand for resource transfers
 - An increasing potential for conflicts over address space
- The RIPE NCC's goal is to create an enhanced, more robust registry function
