Proposed RIPE NCC Charging Scheme 2022



- The Executive Board proposes to continue with the same “One LIR-One Fee” charging scheme model for 2022
 - Annual fee: EUR 1,400 per LIR account + EUR 50 per Independent number resource assignment
- It’s proposed to reduce the sign-up fee to EUR 1,000

Charge for Independent Resources



- The EUR 50 charge per independent number resource assignment applies to the following:
 - IPv4 and IPv6 PI assignments
 - Anycast assignments
 - IPv4 and IPv6 IXP assignments
 - Legacy IPv4 resource registrations through a sponsoring LIR
- ASNs are excluded from this charge

Reduction of the Sign-up Fee to EUR 1,000



- The main goal is to reduce the entry barrier to new networks
- New LIR accounts are also entitled to receive a /24 of IPv4 address space (rather than a /22 pre-run out)
- By reducing the sign-up fee, we also reduce the costs attached to re-opening a closed LIR account
 - 120 re-openings in 2019; 53 in 2020
- Longer term, this reduces our reliance on the sign-up fee
- Based on budgeted 1,200 new LIR accounts, this would mean a 1.2 million reduction in income

Overview of Executive Board Reasoning



- The Board believes this Charging Scheme continues to provide equality, predictability and simplicity for members
- The trend in LIR closures means that the income generated from this charging scheme will adequately cover costs in 2022
- The 2019 vote on two charging scheme models saw overwhelming majority in favour of the current model over a per registration model (1,221 to 467)
- A further discussion will take place on the charging scheme model at this GM
