Internet Governance in 2018



- **Key events:**

- Internet Governance Forum 2018 in Paris
 - Included speech by President Macron supporting Internet regulation
- ITU Plenipotentiary 2018
- Discussions in UN General Assembly
 - Included formation of High-Level Panel on Digital Cooperation, new cybersecurity-related groups

Internet Governance in 2018



- **Global Internet governance remains fragmented, uncertain**
- **Key stakeholders seem dissatisfied with status quo**
 - Including governments, technical community, business sector
- **Internet governance issues increasingly gaining mainstream attention**

Internet Governance in 2019... and Beyond



- **Key events (in Europe)**

- Internet Governance Forum 2019, 25-29 November, Berlin
- EuroDIG, 18-19 June, The Hague
- An increasing number of national and regional events, many very successfully
 - SEEDIG (South East Europe), Central Asia IGF, APriIGF (Asia Pacific)
