



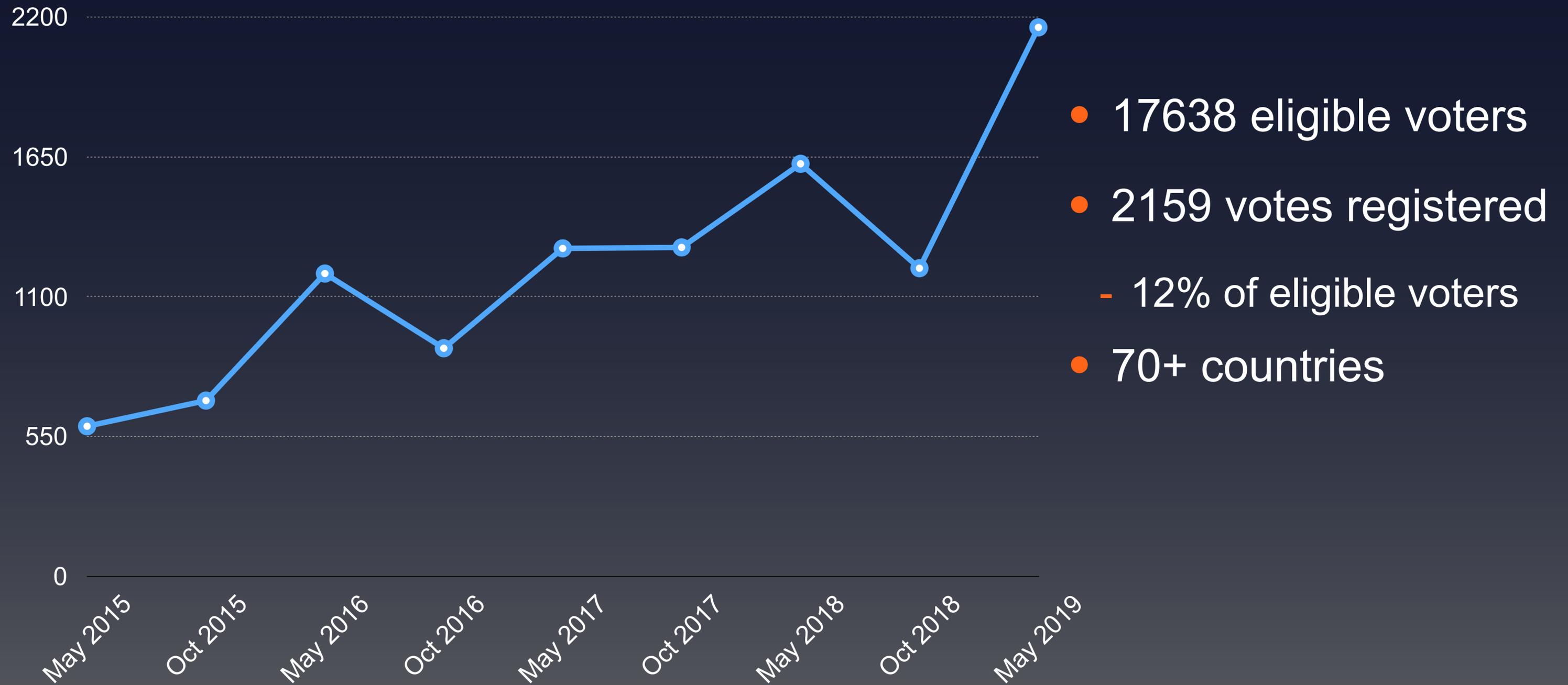

# Voting on Resolutions



- There are five Resolutions to be voted on
- **Resolution 1** requires more than 50% YES votes to pass
- **Resolution 2** requires more than 50% YES votes to pass
- **Resolution 3** requires more than 50% for either option, and that option will pass
- **Resolution 4** requires more than two-thirds YES votes to pass since it proposes amending the RIPE NCC Articles of Association
- **Resolution 5** requires more than 50% YES votes to pass

*Abstentions are noted, but do not count!*

# Executive Board Election



- Seven candidates to fill two seats
- Instant run-off voting is used in the election
- **1 is your most preferred candidate**, and 7 is your least preferred candidate
- Rank the candidates in your order of preference from 1-7
- It's best to rank all candidates to be sure that your vote counts in each potential round

# Executive Board Election



- Candidates need over 50% of votes to be elected
- If no candidate reaches 50% of the votes in the first count, the candidate with the fewest votes is eliminated
- The preferences are then ranked again
- This process continues until a candidate reaches over 50% of the votes
- For seat 2, the ballots are re-used and the process remains the same (discounting the votes for the winner of seat 1)

# How to Vote



**Voting will take place once the Chairman declares voting open**

- **PAPER BALLOTS**

- Attendees only
- Paper ballots must be handed in before you leave this room!

- **ELECTRONIC VOTING**

- Attendees and remote participants
- Electronic votes can be cast until 09:00 UTC (09:00 local time) on Friday, 24 May 2019

# Counting the Votes



- We use a third-party system - BigPulse - for voting
- Paper ballots are stored in the hotel safe until 09:00 UTC on Friday, 24 May
- After the voting deadline has passed, the paper ballots are added to the electronic votes using the BigPulse system
- Independent observers from other RIRs oversee the input of paper ballots into the system
- Geoff Huston and Craig Ng are the independent observers for this GM
