








Registration Overview



- 19,477 eligible voters
- 3,551 votes registered
 - 18.2% of eligible voters
- 84 countries

Registration by Country



- Top five countries
 - Germany: 400
 - Russia: 297
 - France: 295
 - UK: 282
 - Netherlands: 256

Voting on Resolutions



- There are three Resolutions to be voted on
- Resolution 1 requires more than 50% YES votes to pass
- Resolution 2 requires more than 50% YES votes to pass
- Resolution 3 requires more than 50% YES votes to pass

Note: Abstentions are noted, but do not count!

Executive Board Elections



- 8 candidates to fill 3 seats
- Instant run-off voting is used in the election
- Ranking candidates:
 - You must fill at least one preference for a ballot to be considered valid (or choose to abstain)
 - You must number your candidates in order of preference with 1 being your top preference
 - You can choose to fill as many preferences as there are candidates

Executive Board Elections





- Instant Run-off Voting is a preferential voting system where candidates must receive more than 50% of top preference votes to be elected
- If no candidate receives more than 50% in a round of voting, the candidate with the fewest top preference votes is eliminated
- The system then recalculates after redistributing votes according to the order of preference
- This process of elimination and recalculation continues until a candidate receives more than 50% of top preference votes
- For seats 2 and 3, the ballots are re-used and the process remains the same (discounting the votes for the winners of seat 1 and 2)

How to Vote



- Voting can take place once the Executive Board declares voting open
- Voting by paper ballot is not an option at this GM
- Electronic voting is available to all participants
- Electronic votes can be cast until 09:00 Amsterdam local time (UTC+2) on Friday, 15 May 2020
- We use a third-party system - BigPulse - for voting
