Réseaux IP Européens (RIPE)



- Started in 1989 by early adopters to promote IP
- Goal: a stable and secure Internet infrastructure
 - Best Current Practices (BCPs)
 - Information exchange
 - Policy development
- No legal structure, most work done by volunteers
- Open to anybody!

RIPE and the RIPE NCC



RIPE - The community

- Formed in 1989
- Open to all
- Information exchange
- Technical coordination
- Policy development
- Many tasks done by volunteers

RIPE NCC - The secretariat

- Formalised by RIPE in 1992
- Membership organisation
- Run by RIPE NCC staff and Board elected by members
- Provides services
- Secretariat for RIPE community
- Implements policies
