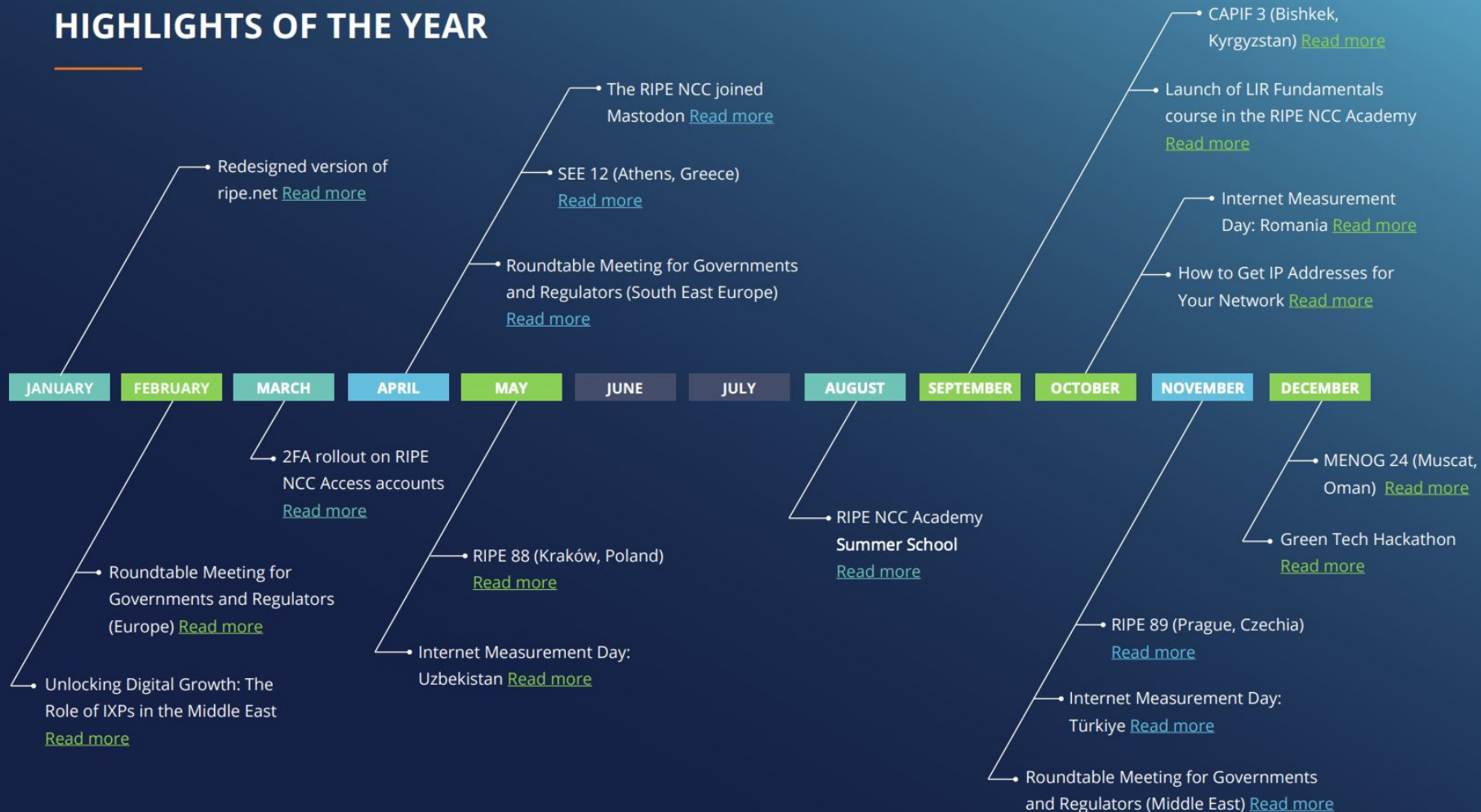

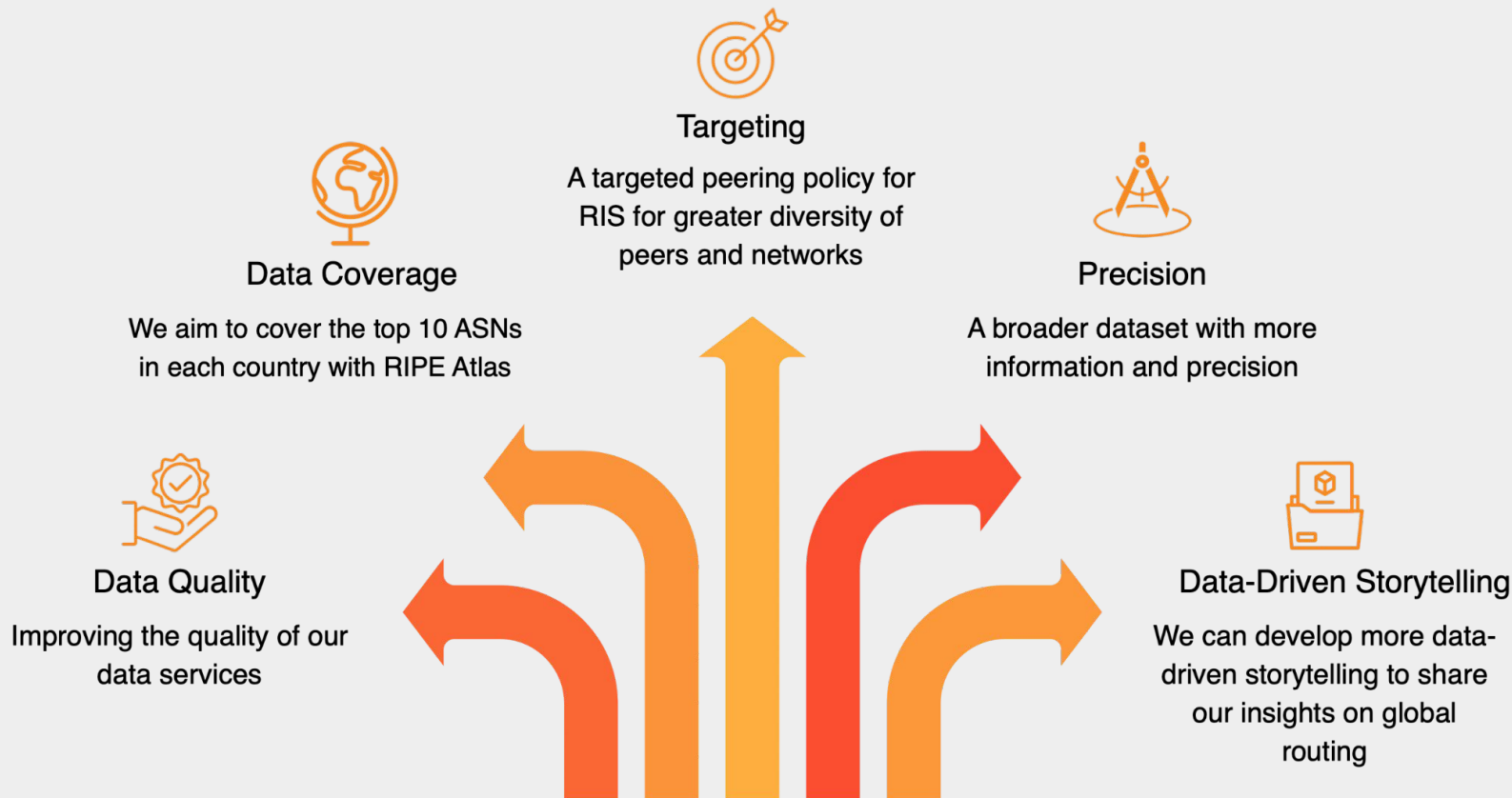

  - These dialogues should to be open to everyone



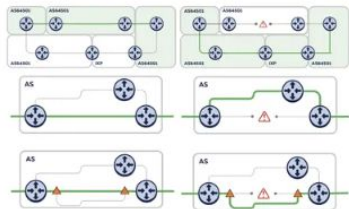

### A Deep Dive Into the Baltic Sea Cable Cuts

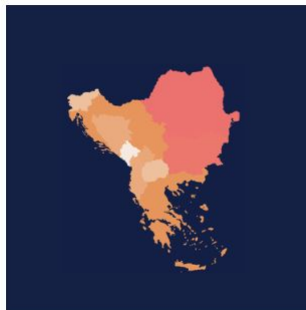
