Proposed amendments for Article 9 - Part 2: Further amendments for the clarification of the process

- Current wording might give the impression that in the event • that the number of nominees does not exceed the number of vacancies, the nominated person is "automatically appointed".
- It is suggested to move the description of this process to Article 18.2 to avoid this misunderstanding.
