Selection Process

- The selection committee starts the process of scoring each application. This is done points:
 - Quality plan/approach
 - Quality team
 - Diversity team
 - Innovation
 - Knowledge sharing/general interest
 - Impact
- committee then meets to select the winning projects from this top 10 List.

Funding Details

- A project can be funded more than once
- There is no minimum amount of funding that must be disbursed each year
- There is no limit on the number of projects that can be funded per year
- Funding may be used to purchase equipment, but this cannot be the sole expenditure
- Funding cannot be used for humanitarian aid, donations, or to encourage political reform
- Funding cannot be used to provide scholarships or cover tuition fees Funding cannot be used to support any form of commercial activity
