Why an NCC?

- RIPE participation was increasing
- Too much RIPE work to be done on a voluntary basis
- Activities require continuity & coordination
- Neutrality and impartiality is important
- Contact point inside & outside RIPE region



What is the RIPE NCC?

- Not for profit membership association
 - under Dutch law
 - incorporated 1997 (but active since 1992)
 - Funded solely by members, thus fully autonomous
 - Membership open to all interested parties
 - elects Executive Board
 - guides activities & budget
 - approves fees (“Charging Scheme”)
- Policies for RIPE NCC activities are developed by industry at large
 - “Bottom Up Industry Self Regulation”
 - Through open policy processes during RIPE Meetings and on mailing lists.

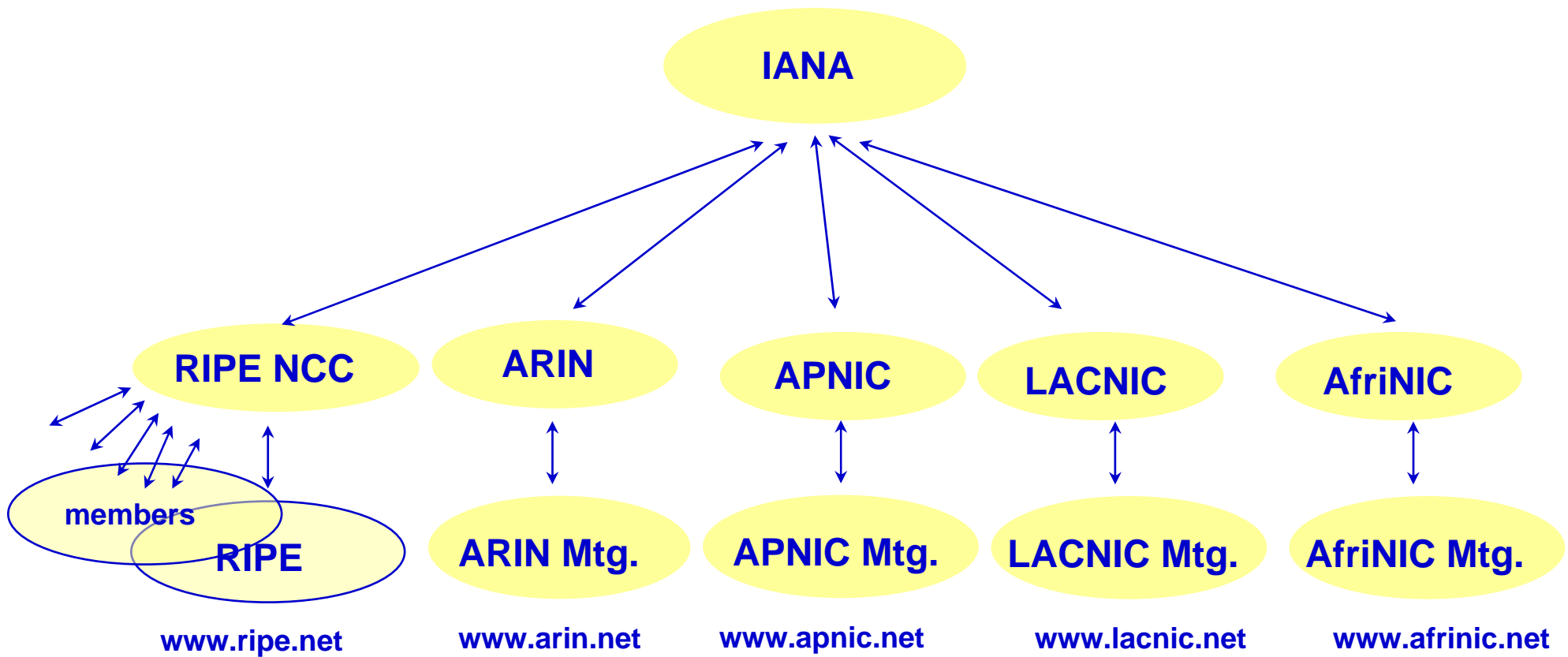




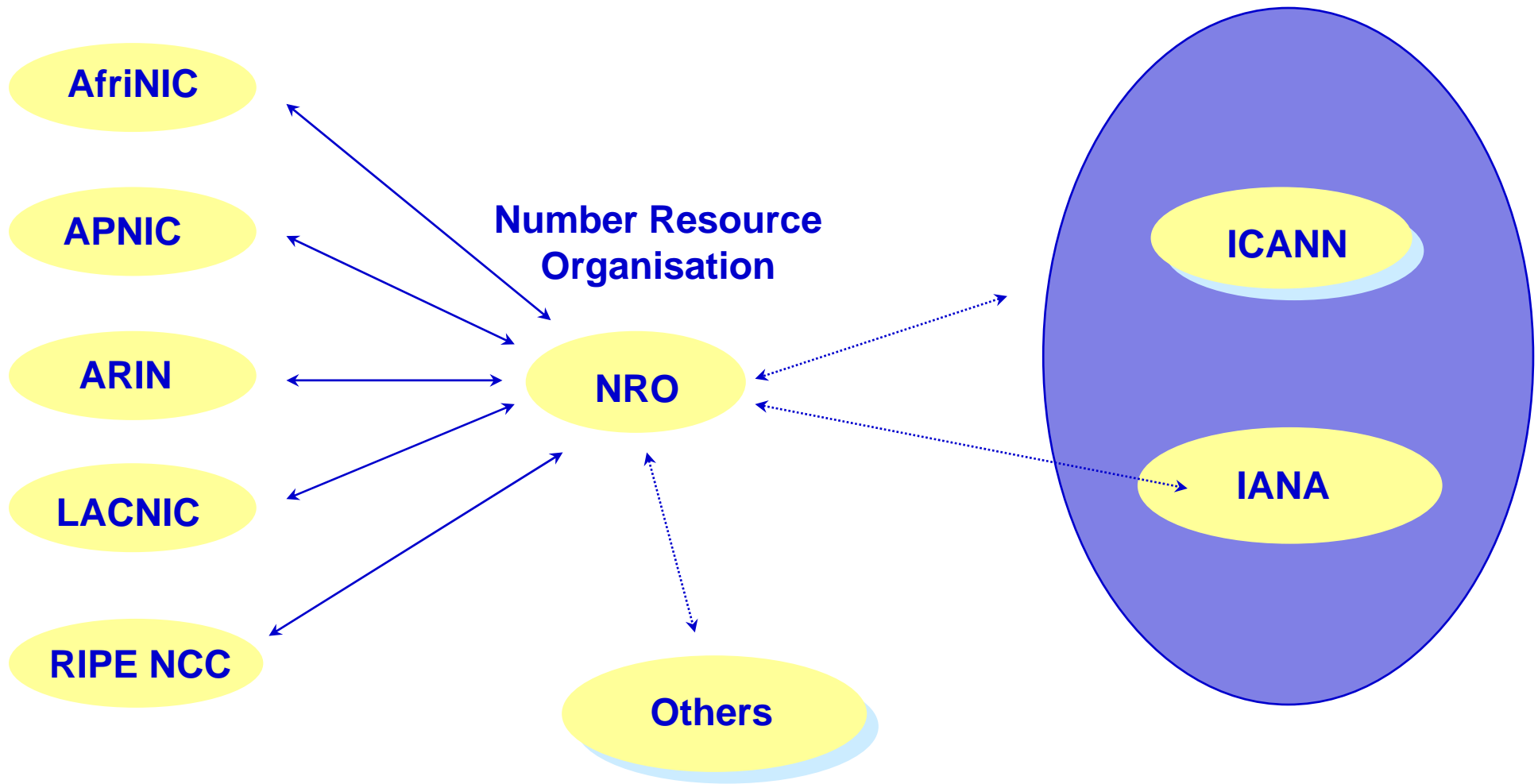

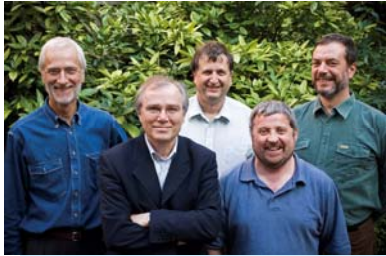
What are the RIPE NCC's tasks?

- Co-ordination and provision of services for its members & RIPE community
 - Membership Services
 - Coordination Services
 - Information Services
- Operate one of five Regional Internet Registries (RIRs)
 - Responsible stewardship of Internet Resources
 - IPv4, IPv6 addresses, ASNs
 - Allocation and Registration
 - AfriNIC, ARIN, APNIC, LACNIC, RIPE NCC

Organisational Statistics

- Located in Amsterdam, The Netherlands
- Statistics
 - 1992
 - 3 staff
 - No Local Internet Registries (LIRs)
 - 7,955 objects in the RIPE Database (June '92)
 - Budget 243 k ECU
 - 2006
 - 90+ staff (24 nationalities)
 - 4200+ participating LIR's / members
 - 3,200,000+ objects in the RIPE Database
 - Budget 10.8 M EUR
