---

- Contributing to European Commission discussions and strategies
  - Workshops, conferences, events following on from Action Plan for the Deployment of IPv6 in Europe (2008)
  - Most recently Poznan, October 2011
- Collaborated in development of IPv6 Deployment Monitoring Survey, 2009-2010

# EP3R

---

- European Public-Private Partnership for Resilience
  - Identifying and protecting European critical Internet infrastructure
  - IP address registry? Root name servers? Internet Exchange Points?

# Public Sector ICT Procurement

---

- Contributed to open consultation and draft guidelines produced by European Economics
- Noted RIPE Document “Requirements For IPv6 in ICT Equipment” (ripe-501)
  - Ensuring awareness of existing technical community initiatives that may be relevant

# Data Protection

---

- Participation in public consultation, launched December 2009
  - Follow-up roundtable meeting
- Positive outcome from private sector involvement
  - More realistic perspective on IP addresses as personal data
