 - Serve as a focal point for the RIPE NCC regarding community input to their IoT activities, including liaisons
 - Invite IoT communities to for a dialogue on matters of operational relevance, including security, the numbering system, and applicability of standards
 - Develop positions of the RIPE community on IoT matters, operational and beyond
