 - Primarily European (but members from 4 continents)

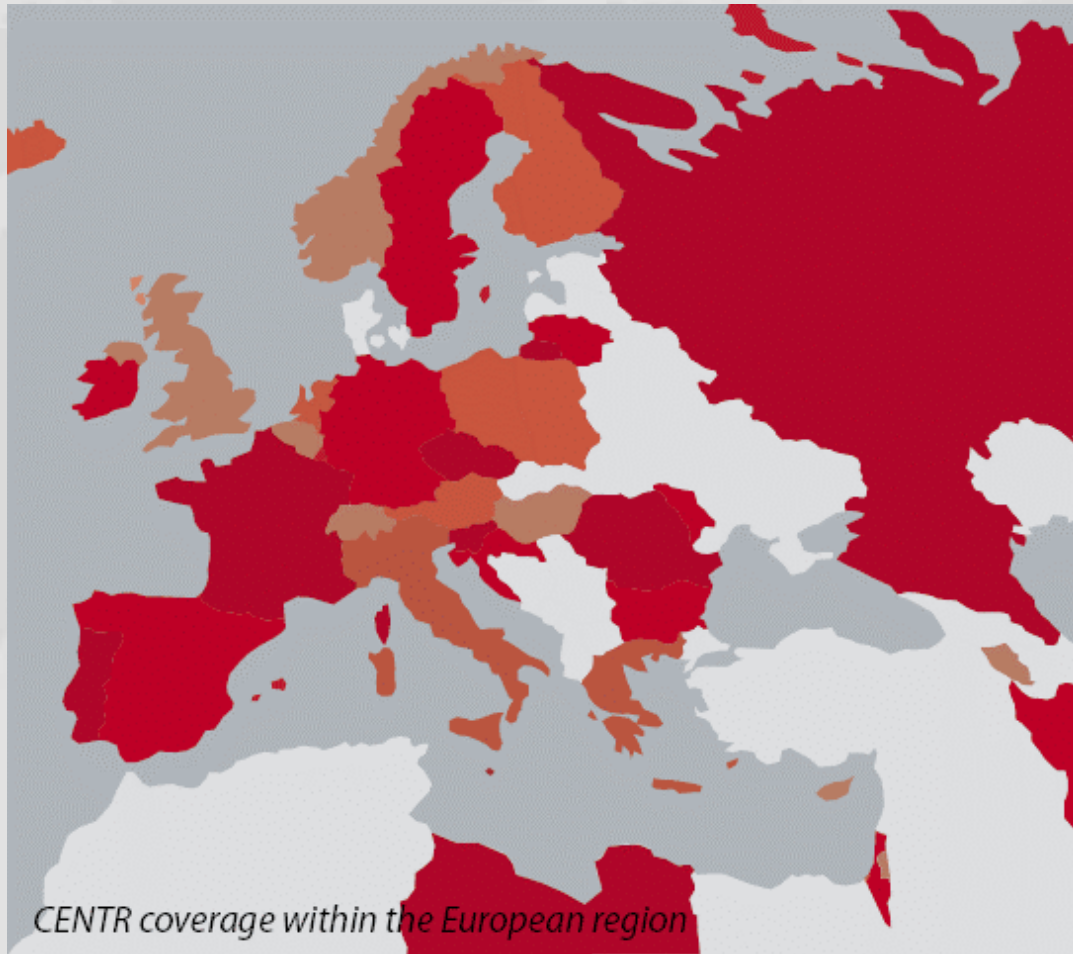


CENTR's History

CENTR's Position

- A “regional” ccTLD organisation
 - 3 others: LACTLD, AFTLD, APTLD
- No strict geographic boundaries like RIRs. Countries free to self-select region, participate in different organisations.
- Recognised as a key representative body for TLDs (by ICANN, ITU, European Commission, governments etc.)



Topical Issues

- Internationalised Domain Names
 - Allows non-ASCII characters in domains
 - For example, Cyrillic
 - Still in early stages
 - Registration available in some countries
 - Software support still needs work
- Privacy Policies
 - Ensuring registries abide by relevant laws and regulations for protection of personal data.
- ICANN, IANA, ccNSO, and governance
 - Working with relevant parties to ensure proper regulatory and coordination framework for TLD operations.
 - Ensuring the Internet root is stable, whilst protecting each country's Internet community's right to administer their own ccTLD as they see fit.
 - Ensuring the IANA (root) services are run simply and effectively.



Topical Issues

- Monitoring Services
 - Keeping an accurate track of how the DNS is working
 - Helps identify any problems, producing a more stable system.
- DNS Security
 - Enhancing the accuracy of the DNS by using cryptography
 - Techniques allow for verifying DNS data hasn't been tampered with.
- ENUM
 - Maps telephone numbers to domain names
 - Many ccTLD registries are responsible for the trials or deployment of ENUM in their countries
- Outreach
 - European countries providing other regions (i.e. Africa) with assistance.



Benefits of Diverse Participation

- CENTR values participation from many different registries
 - Western and Eastern Europe, Americas, Asia
 - Different regulatory regimes, Internet community expectations, use of domain names etc.
 - Different challenges in ensuring stable DNS/Internet
- Provides diverse viewpoints
 - Brings different perspectives to discussion of issues.
 - Helps CENTR define policies that benefit everyone.
 - Comes to agreed opinions based on this diverse dialogue within CENTR, so there is a unified opinion to the global arena.
