#### .INFO IDN Launch


- Launched for German script only
  - Only umlaut domains ä, ö, and ü
  - Germany is most popular non-US market
    - Germany accounts for over 22% of worldwide .INFO registrations
    - INFO currently contains over 400,000 live sites, of which 33% are operated by German registrants.
- Punycode only registrations
- Registrations opened 16 March 2004
- Registrations made during the first 30 days locked to facilitate UDRP claims

#### Launch results

- Registry system 100% stable
  - Innovative rate limiting procedures in place to handle demand
- Within the first 24 hours over 13,000 names were registered
  - First name was kinderbücher.info (children books)
- 66% of IDN registrants were new .INFO registrants
- Majority of registrants from Germany (over 80%)
  - Followed by Austria and Switzerland

# Support for registrars during IDN launch

- Specialized Registrar ToolKit (RTK)
  - Contained NamePrep engine and EPP extensions to register IDNs
- Detailed Web cast and optional Operational Testing & Evaluation (OT&E) environment provided
- Registrars required to tag IDN domain names by a "script" (e.g.: "de" for German)



## .INFO WHOIS support for IDNs

Port 43 and Web-based WHOIS only displays Punycode registration in "domain name" field

 WHOIS lookups with encoded characters



 Three WHOIS fields added to support additional display fields for usability

IDN Script: de

Unicode Hex: U+006B U+0069 U+006E U+0064 U+0065 U+0072 U+0062

U+00FC U+0063 U+0068 U+0065 U+0072

Unicode HTML: kinderbücher



## **Examples**

- German word: Kinderbücher
- Normalises to: kinderbücher
- In punycode: kinderbcher-zhb
- Domain: xn--kinderbcher-zhb.info

Punycode is just a way of writing Unicode characters in 'legal domain name' ASCII
