- servers identified by DE hostcount for March 2004
- survey run early May 2004
- asked servers for DE, not necessarily in DE




main course

- approx. 55.000 servers identified
- received answers from 25.500 different IP addresses
- many servers are multinamed
- ... some do not exist, others have bogus addresses
- found 19 products in 38 versions
- charts only take into account responsive servers




Servers by number






Servers by delegation






Servers by weighted delegation









some water into the wine

- third chart still treats all zones equally
- which ones are really *used*?
- really need to know query distribution, to be measured at busy resolvers with large customer base
- isn't resolver software at least as important?
- measure that at the server side?



desert

- recursion available at 64% of all servers!
- some are both multihomed and multinamed
- topmost multihomed server has 201 IP addresses!
 ...but serves only a single zone
- some systems suffer from *split personality* BIND 8.1-REL vs. BIND 8.2.2-P3
- PowerDNS follows up with SOA query after NOTIFY for "."
- one server (auto)magically tries to load jjjjjjj from test system
- manual (and automated!) reactions due to tracks left
