Provider Independent (PI)

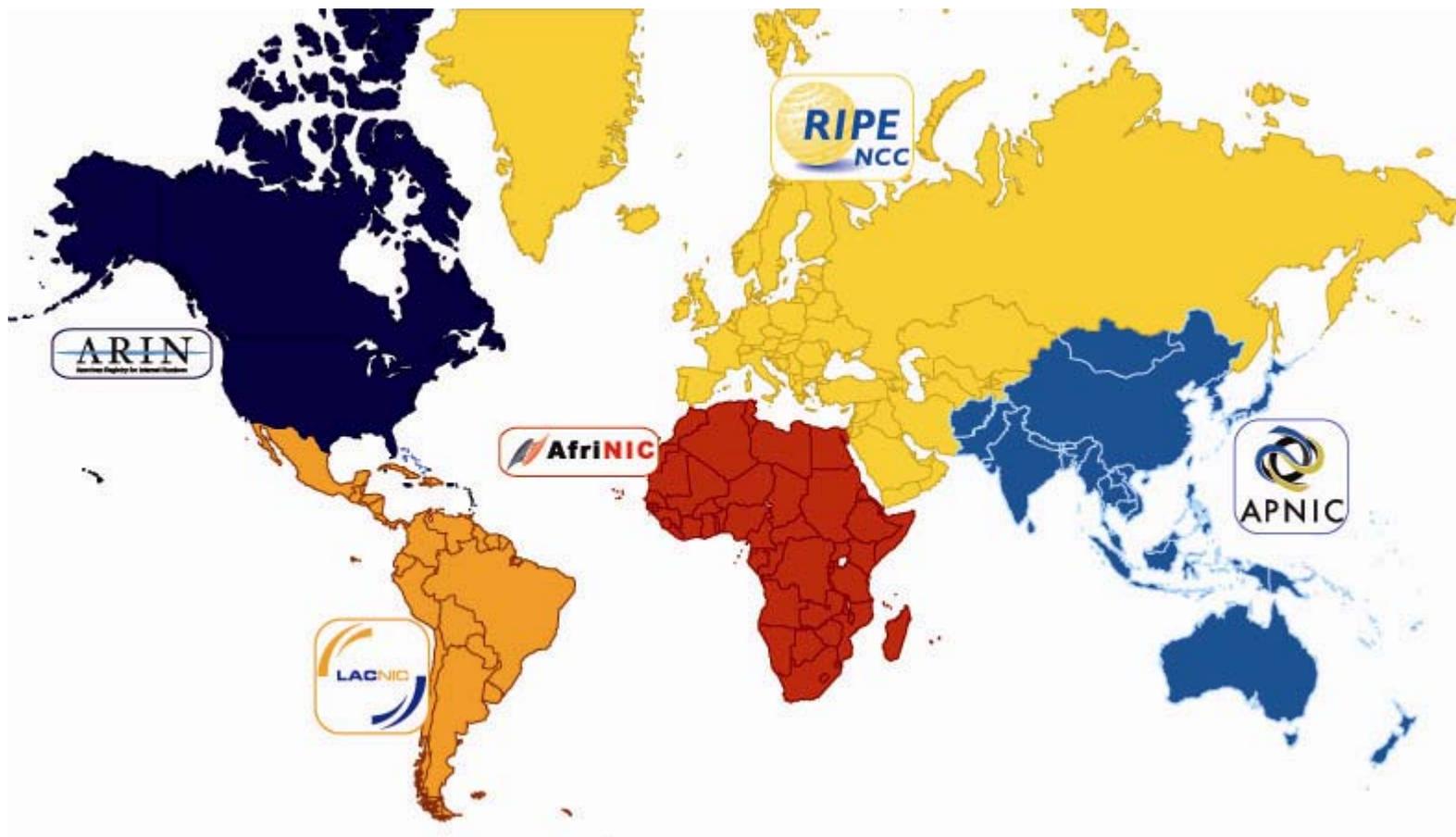
- To End-User, through LIR, by RIPE NCC
- No Hierarchy
- No Aggregation

- Multihoming
- Avoid Renumbering
- Independence

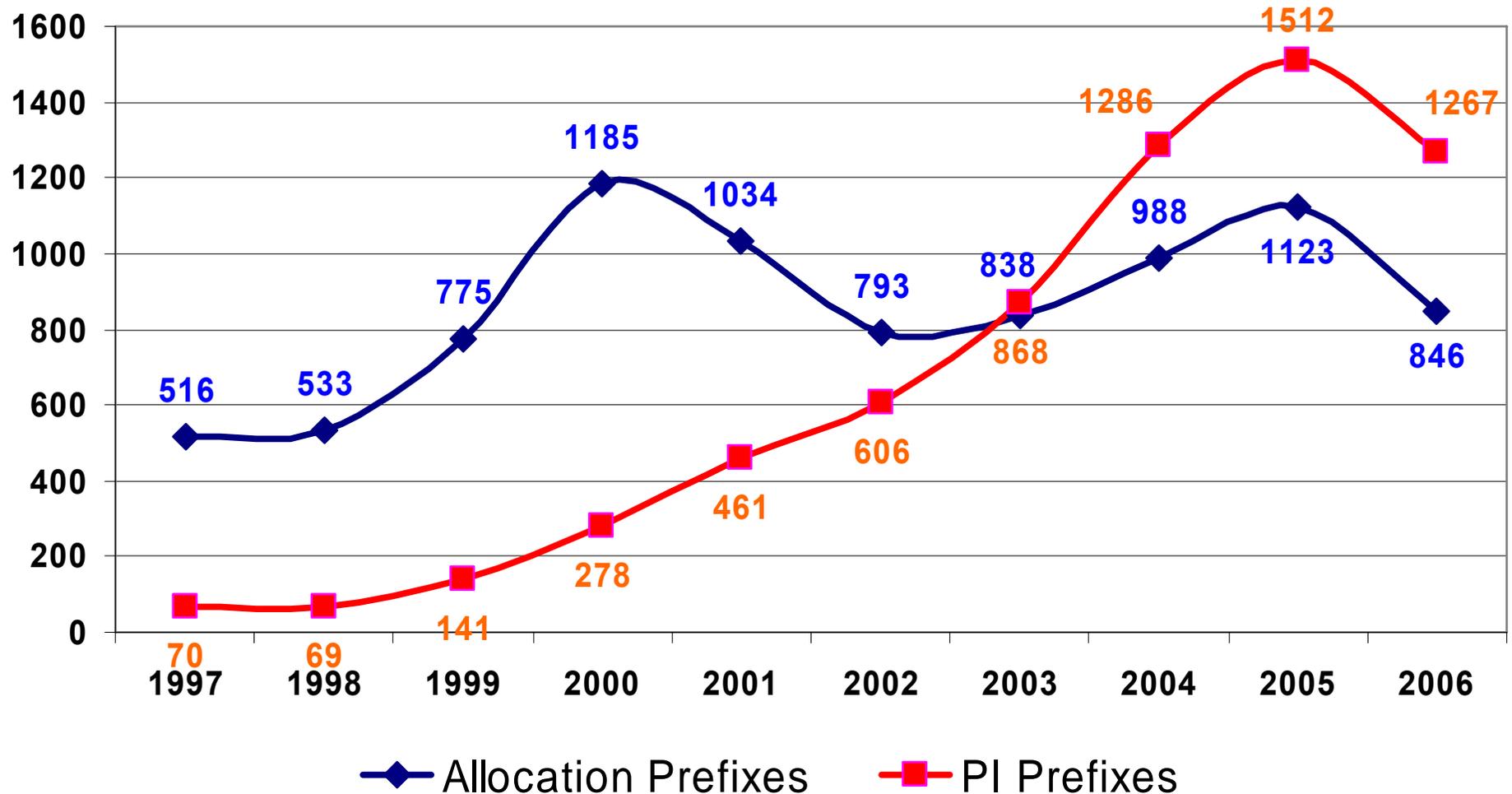

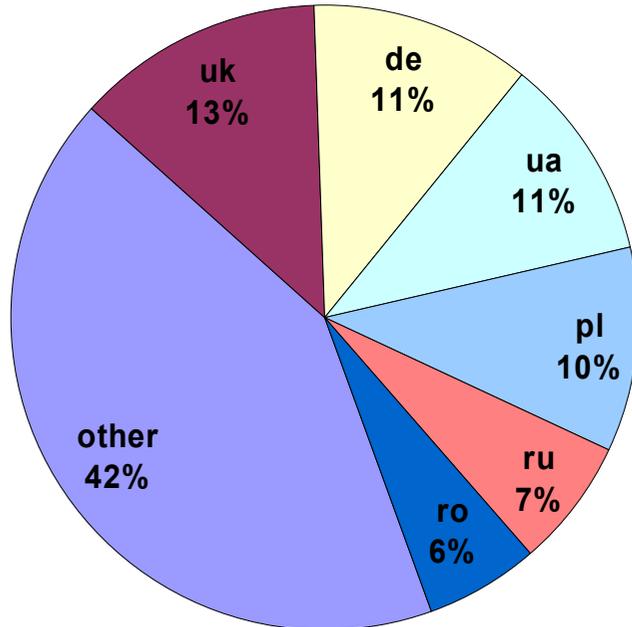


PI and Allocation Prefixes

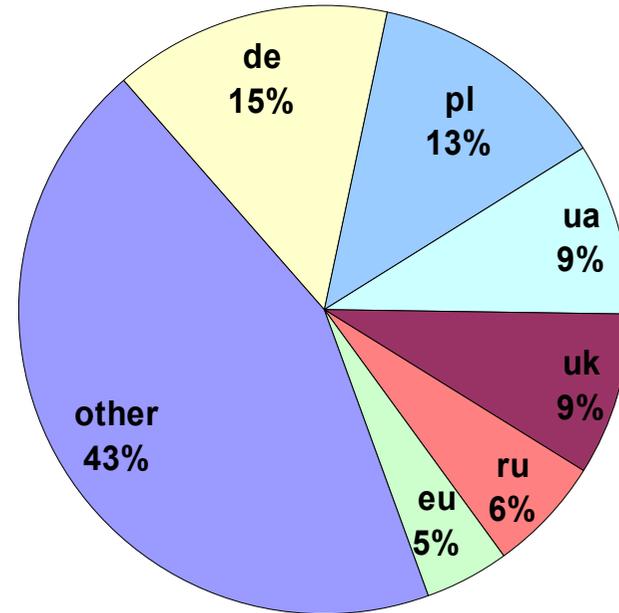


Top 6 Countries (1997 – current)

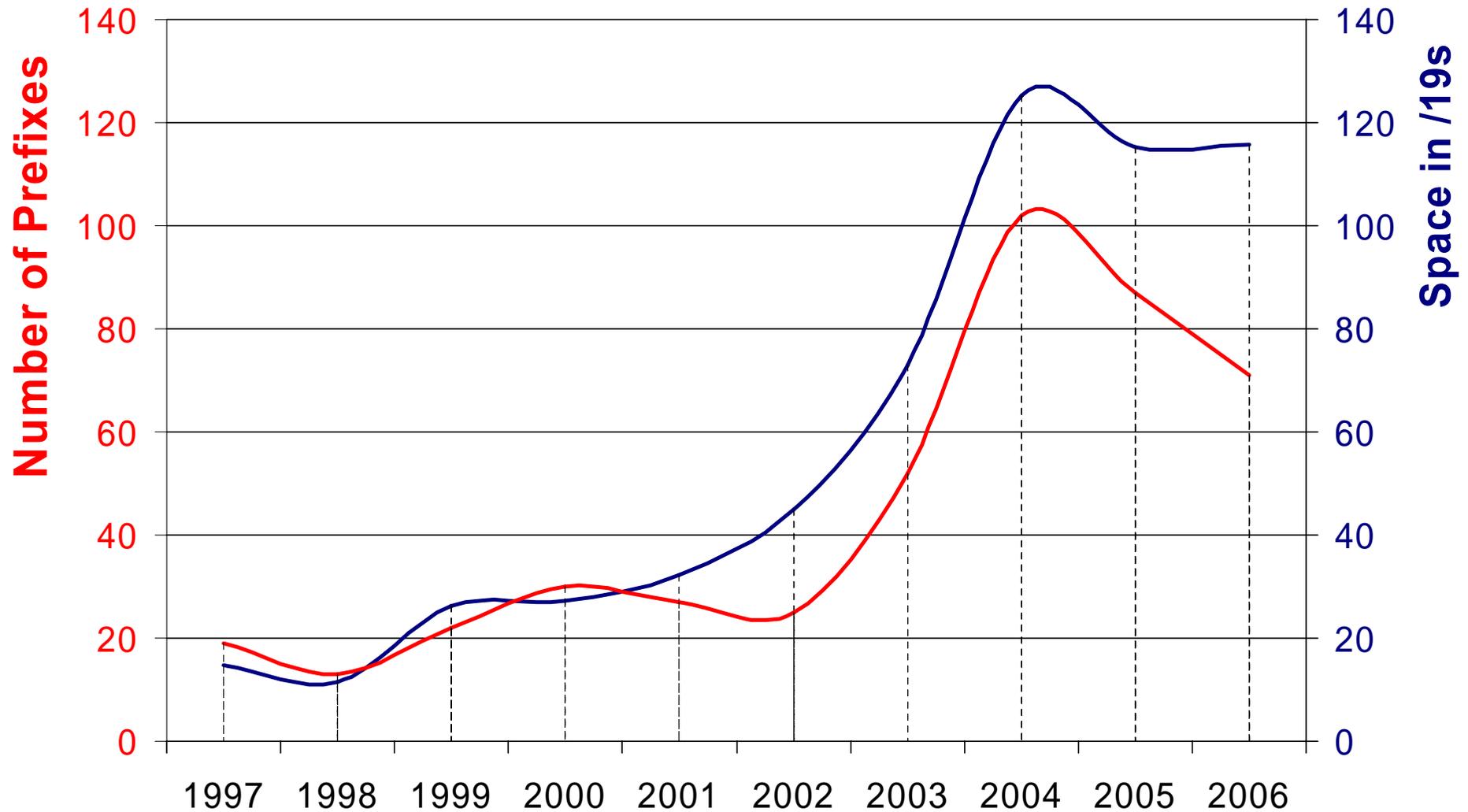
Number of PI prefixes



Amount of PI address space

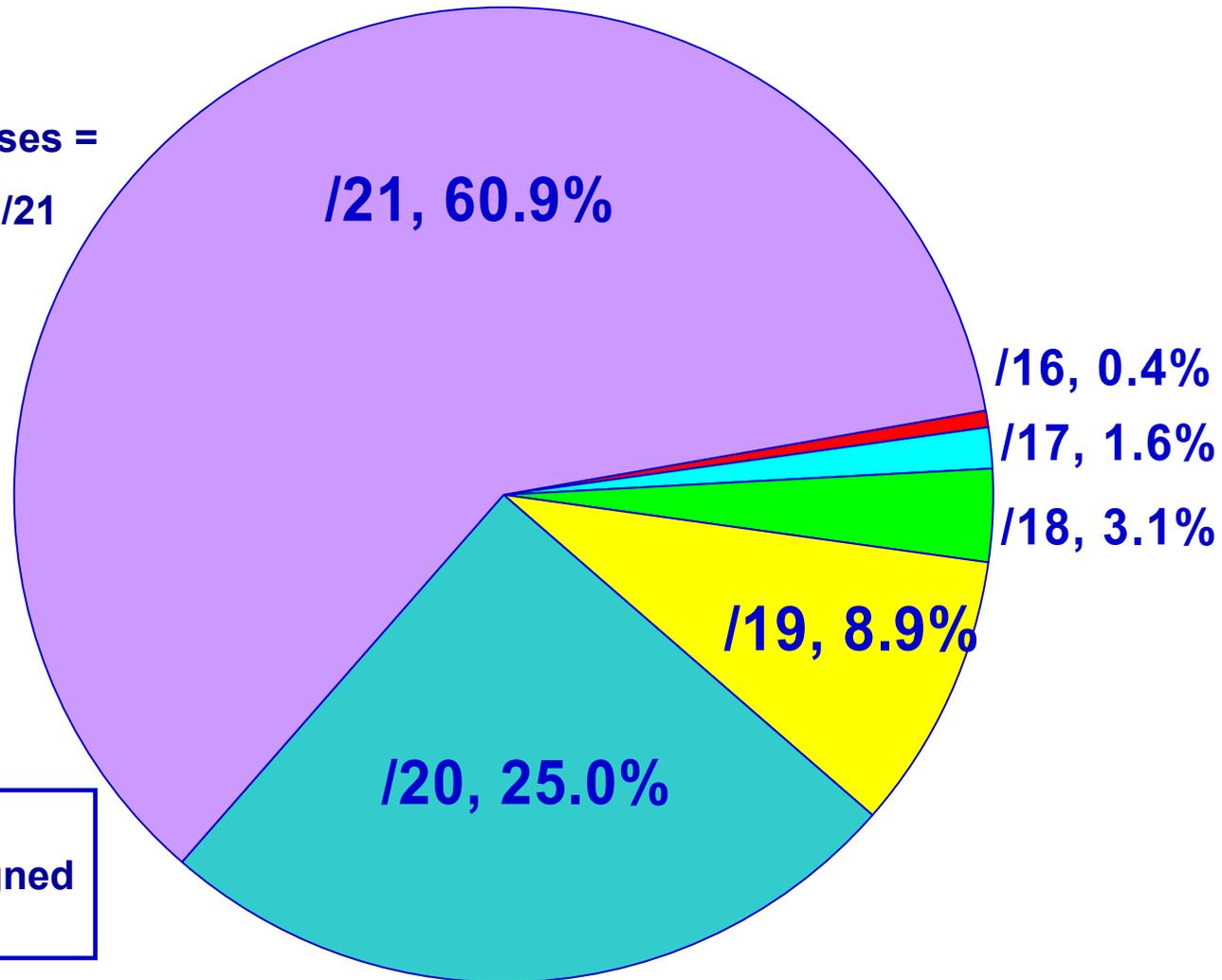

PI Assignments \geq /21 (1997 - current)

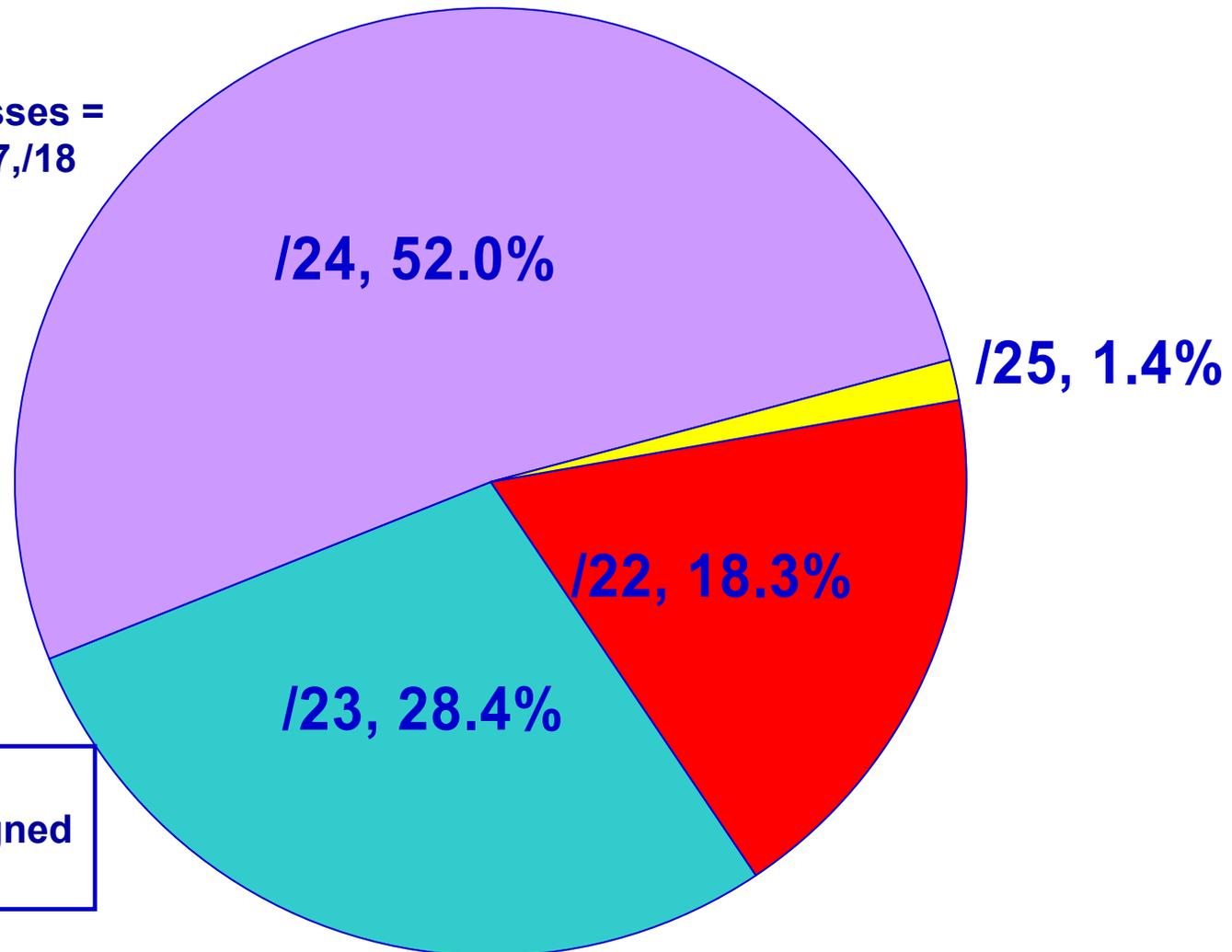
