# Istanbul IX

- 1600 m<sup>2</sup> of colocation floorspace in the Mediteranean Nautilus undersea cable head!
- Global connectivity from multiple international carriers either via undersea link or terrestrial fiber
- Redundant fiber connectivity from multiple Turkish operators including Turk Telekom and Superonline
- Only carrier-neutral IX in the region with the ability to reach Jordan, Israel, Iraq, Iran and Syria
- Force10 peering platform
