

RACI Application Guidance Notes

1. Applicants may apply individually, or in teams of two.
2. All applications must be made in English.
3. RACI applicants must be undergraduate or postgraduate students at a recognised, established academic organisation or institution located within the [RIPE NCC service region](#).
4. RACI applicants must submit provide slides of what they intend to present at the upcoming RIPE Meeting (500 words max).
5. Proposed topics must be of interest to the RIPE Community.
6. Submission abstracts will be reviewed by the RIPE Programme Committee, who will select RACI applicants at their discretion.
7. The applicants selected under RACI will be awarded complimentary tickets to the week-long RIPE Meeting, including lunches and social events, including the RIPE Dinner. This ticket will include accommodation and travel costs that will be arranged by the RIPE NCC.
8. At least one of the chosen RACI attendees will present their topic at the upcoming RIPE Meeting in a plenary/working group session, or in lightning talks at other designated sessions. Upon being informed of their selection, RACI attendees will also be informed as to the scheduling of their presentation.
